Main decisions from FIS Council Meeting, 7th November 2005

The following important decisions were taken by the Council at its Meeting at the FIS Headquarters in Oberhofen (SUI) on 7th November, 2005:

FIS World Cup

- FIS World Cup Calendars for 2006/2007 for the majority of disciplines were approved, subject to the final calendar proposals from the Alpine Committee in spring 2006 (pdf downloads will be available on the FIS Website, www.fis-ski.com, FIS Calendar).

FIS World Championships

- Competition programmes for the 2007 FIS World Championships approved (Nordic Events – Sapporo, JPN; Alpine Events - Are, SWE; Snowboard Events – Arosa, SUI)
- Following the extension to 1st October 2005 of the deadline for applications as candidates for the in the Freestyle and Ski Flying Events, the following new candidatures were confirmed:

2010 FIS Ski Flying Ski Championships
Planica (SLO)

2011 FIS Freestyle World Ski Championships
Phenix Park (KOR)
Deer Valley (USA)

Organisers of the following FIS Junior World Championships were appointed:

- 2008 Alpine Events, Spain
- 2006 Freestyle Events, St. Petersburg/Red Lake Area (RUS)

Acknowledgment of the proposals of the Technical Committees for the following events:

- 2007 Roller Skiing World Championships in Bergamo (ITA)
- 2007 Telemark World Championships in Thyon (SUI)

- To introduce the FIS Cross-Country World Cup “Tour de Ski” from 2006/2007
- Qualification runs for Downhill only take place on last scheduled training day (in other cases the top 30 of the World Cup Starting List, WCSL applies)
- Recognition of Snowboard Slopestyle
- Medical Committee to undertake preliminary investigations to develop an Injury Surveillance System
- Adaptations to other rules for Nordic Combined, Freestyle Skiing, Grass Skiing, Telemark, Citizen Competitions

- Applications for FIS Solidarity financial support

Affiliation of National Ski Associations

- Three National Ski Associations; the Cayman Islands, Ethiopia and Bermuda, were affiliated as provisional associate members subject to ratification by the Congress in 2006
