

## FIS points on FIS Marathon Cup competitions

On the 80th Meeting of the Cross-Country Committee at Dubrovnik (CRO) Saturday, 23rd May 2009 it was decided to award FIS points to FIS Marathon Cup competitions.

The FIS Cross Country Committee and the FIS Council agreed on the 81th Meeting at Antalya (TUR) on 2<sup>nd</sup> June respectively 5<sup>th</sup> June 2010 to the following principles for the second trial during season 2010/2011:

1. The existing Rules and Guidelines for FIS points 2010/2011 are valid for this trial
2. Only the official main competition with a FIS Codex/Category "MC" of each FIS Marathon Cup competition will be scored
3. The FIS Marathon Cup competition have the standard of a FIS competition
4. The Factor 1400 (F-Value) for competitions with Mass start is used
5. The race penalty is generated according to Art. 5.3
6. The minimum penalty points is 15
7. Only competitors with valid FIS code will be counted
8. If an athlete with an inactive FIS Code starts in a FIS Marathon Cup his FIS Code automatically will change into status active
9. Competitors ranked with more than 10% race time behind the winner race time will not be counted/will not receive FIS points
10. Organizers must submit results in XML format within the same day after the competition to FIS: [alpineresults@fisski.ch](mailto:alpineresults@fisski.ch)
11. The Technical Delegate must submit the TD report **and the penalty sheet** within 3 days after the competition to: [lessing@fisski.com](mailto:lessing@fisski.com)
12. The FIS Marathon Cup management is responsible for the information to the Organizing Committees, handling and transfer of the lists.
