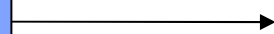

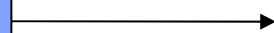

II WHEREABOUTS

- Information must include **24h/day**
- **NEW:** In addition to define a **60 minute time-slot**
between 6 am – 11 pm for every day
- must be submitted on a **quarterly** basis before the
beginning of each quarter
(April/May/June; July/August/Sept.; Oct/Nov/Dec; Jan/Feb/March)
- to be submitted on-line through **ADAMS**

III WHEREABOUTS - UPDATE

- Whereabouts must be **current** at all times
- **UPDATE** of Whereabouts:
 1. Through ADAMS (click „resubmit!“)
 2. Short-notice change via SMS to ADAMS
(register your mobile number in ADAMS first)
 3. Short-notice change via SMS to FIS
(register your mobile number antidoping@fisski.com)

IV FILING FAILURE / MISSED TEST

1. FILING FAILURE

- No Whereabouts
- Incomplete Whereabouts
- Incorrect Whereabouts

2. MISSED TEST

- Not available for a Doping control during the 60 minute time-slot indicated by the athlete

IV FILING FAILURE / MISSED TEST

3. CONSEQUENCE

Any combination of 3 Filing Failures and/or Missed Tests committed within an 18-month period at an international (FIS) or national (NADO) level, will constitute an

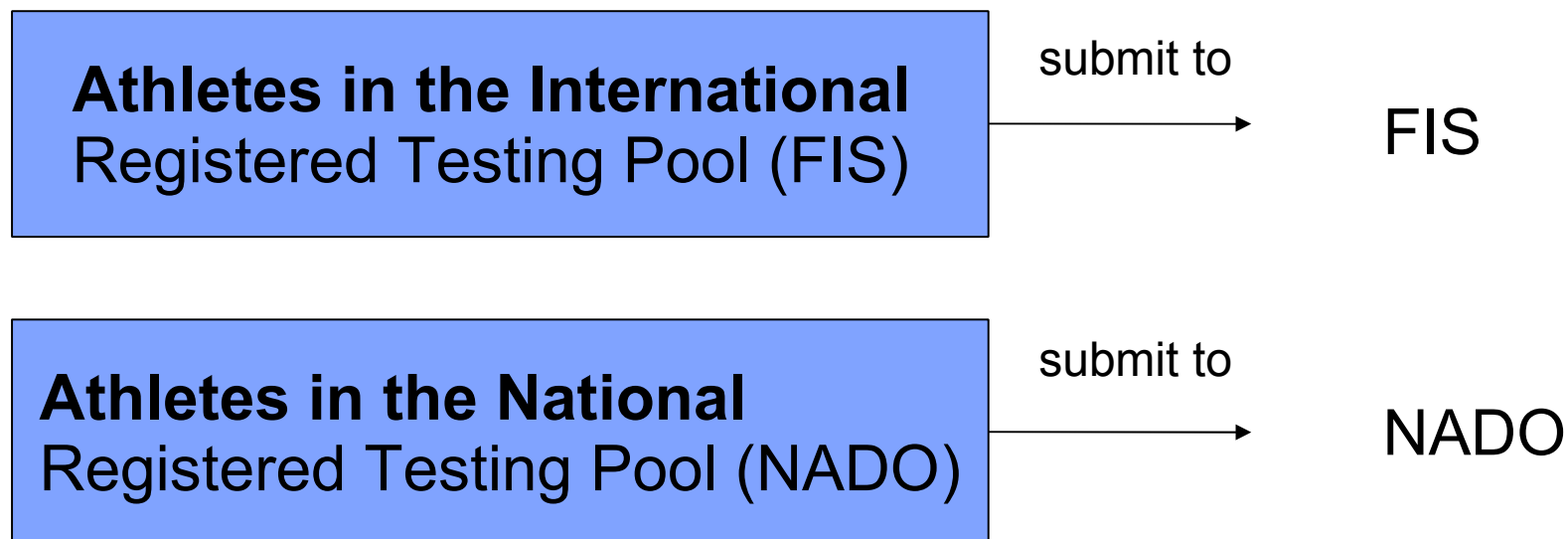
ANTI-DOPING RULE VIOLATION (1-2 years)



V RETIREMENT

An athlete has to provide Whereabouts until the National Ski Association gives written notice to FIS that the athlete has retired (FIS retirement form)

VI THERAPEUTIC USE EXEMPTION
