### No Doping Case against Vincent Vittoz (FRA)

---

On Tuesday 8<sup>th</sup> February the B Sample of Vincent Vittoz (FRA) was analysed at the WADA accredited laboratory in Cologne (GER), whereby the result **did not** confirm the A Sample which has shown the presence of Furosemide. Therefore according to article 7.1.6 of the FIS Anti-Doping Rules that are complied in accordance with the World Anti-Doping Code there is **no doping case** against the Athlete:

“If the B Sample proves negative, the entire **test shall be considered negative** and the Athlete through his National Ski Association, shall be so informed by FIS”.

A thorough review is presently being undertaken by the WADA accredited laboratory in Cologne (GER) to discover the reason for this occurrence.

The disclosure of the adverse analytical finding in the A Sample was made by the Athlete himself instead of following the procedures defined in the regulations whereby communication of a doping case by FIS is only made after the analysis of the B Sample which confirms the adverse analytical finding of the A Sample.
