NOTE

How point scores are calculated:

An athlete is awarded 60 points for jumping the K-point distance. For every meter more or less than the K-point, a competitor has 2.0 points added or subtracted from his total. In addition, competitors are awarded points for style (for flight and landing) up to a maximum of 20 per judge. Five judges score each jump, with the highest and lowest scores disregarded and the scores of the other three aggregated and added to the competitor's points for distance.
