2. Registration

Team registration will take place daily starting Saturday, January 29st 2005, from 15.00 to 20.00 at the Accreditation Office/Race Office:

3. Accommodation

As per the FIS Rule on accommodation (half board), each participant will pay CHF 50/day/person at the Accreditation Office . Accommodation at FIS rate will be provided only for the nights of January 29th to February 02nd , 2005.
Each team will be held responsible for any damage incurred during the stay.

4. Transportation

Teams are responsible for their own transportation.

5. Meals

Breakfast and dinner will be provided, starting with dinner on Saturday, January 29th, including the breakfast on Wednesday, February 2th 2005.
Only breakfast will be given in the hotels – Lunch and dinner will be given from February 29th till February 1th at the VIP tent in the race area, not in the hotel.

6. Prize Money

Prize money will be payed out according to the FIS rules directly after the race at the reception of the Hotel Arena next to the race area.

7. Bibs

All competitors must wear bibs during all official training, competition and award ceremonies.

8. Accident Insurance

Each competitor must have his/her own medical insurance. The Organizing Committee, sponsors, suppliers, their agents, Maribor, the OK Maribor, the FIS and the Slovenian Ski Association decline any responsibility for accidents, damaged or lost equipment and second and third party claims during the event.

9. Liability

All athletes, officials and members of the National Association who attend and participate in the event shall do so at their own risk. The Organizing Committee, Maribor, the Slovenian Ski Association, sponsors and suppliers, their agents, employees and volunteers shall not be responsible for any losses or injuries incurred or suffered by any athlete, official or other person in conjunction with the organizing or staging of the event.

10. Official Notice Board

The official Notice Board will be located at the race office at the Hotel Arena and in the race/finish area.
