#### 2. Rules

- a) The Czech Ski Federation and The Organizing Committee are organizing an International Freestyle World Cup competitions, part of the Freestyle FIS World Cup 2006 held under FIS rules and regulations for freestyle skiing
- b) The competition is composed of one Ski Cross events for both men and women
- c) The dates for these competitions are published in the International Calendar of the FIS
- d) The competition will follow an official program that will be available to all participans
- e) The Freestyle FIS World Cup 2006 finals will be followed by the winners award ceremony where national team members may be asked to participate
- f) The Organizing Committee has the right to change the competition schedule if necessary

## 3. Entries and important forms

Entries will be accepted from National Ski Associations in accordance with the FIS quotas and rules and must be submitted to the Organizing Committee.

## 4. Competition Headquartes

Is located in Pec p/Snezkou.

#### 5. Team Registration

Team registration will take place daily starting Tuesday, January 31, 2006, from 8:00 AM to 12:00 PM at the Competition Office located in Pec p/Snezkou.

All fees and deposits must be paid upon registration.

#### 6. Accommodation

Accommodation for all teams and officials is provided at various hotels in Pec p/Snezkou and in the area. All participans will get a voucher upon registration at the Competition Office. All teams must first register at the Competition Office.

Accommodation will be provided from Tuesday, January 31 to Saturday, February 4, 2006 (4 nights). Hotels are available on the first come first serve basis.

The Organizing Committe must receive your exact Team Registration no later then January 15, 2006, otherwise the Organizing Commettee will not be able to provide the FIS rates. E-mail is the preferred mean of communication.

At the time of check in at the hotel, a fully refundable damage deposit charget to a major credit card will be required. Each National Association (Team) will be held responsible for any damage incurred during its stay.

#### 7. Meals

Breakfast and dinner will be provided, commencing with dinner on Tuesday, January 31 and concluding with breakfast on Saturday, February 4, 2006. The meal plan will be offered at several on-site locations. Complete information will be provided upon check in at the Competition Office.

#### 8. Ground transportation from Prague Airport to Spindleruv Mlyn

Teams are responsible for looking after their own ground transportation from the airport to Spindleruv Mlyn / in Pec p/Snezkou and return. All major car rental companies are available at the Prague Airport.

## 9. Team Leader's Meeting

The First Team Leader's meeting will be held on Tuesday, January 31, 2006 at 5 PM.

#### **10. Bibs**

All competitors must wear bibs during all official training, competition and award ceremonies. A refundable deposit of EUR 20 or US\$ 20 per bib will be charged upon registration.

#### 11. Liability

All athletes, officials and other members of their National Association who attend and participate in the event shall do so at their own risk. The Organizing Commettee, RWE Transgas, Pec p/Snezkou, The Czech Ski Association, GSMA s.r.o., sponsors, suppliers, their agents, employees and volunteers shall not be held responsible for any losses or injuries incurred or suffered by any athlete, official or other person in conjuction with the organization or staging of the events. All participants are urget not to be negligent in safeguarding their personal belongings at all times. Therefore mentioned parties will také no responsibility for missing belongings.

#### 12. Accident insurance

Every competitor must have his/her own medical insurance. The Organizing Commettee, sponsors, supliers, Pec p/Snezkou, the FIS and the Czech Ski Association decline any responsibility for accidents, damaged equipment and second and third party claims during the event.

#### 13. Accident protocol

In the case of accidents on courses during the event, Medical personnel from the Organizing Commettee and Ski Patrol Personnel will be responsible for any medical decision or evacuation to the local hospital in co-operation with the National Associations' medical personnel on the entry form.

#### 14. Ski storage

All competitors, coaches and officials must store and wax their skis in the room provided by each hotel.

## 15. Vehicle parking

Vehicles will be parket at each hotel's parking. There will be parking available at the site upon parking permit provided by the OC. There is limited parking space therefor the teams staying further away from the site will be promoted.
