2. REGISTRATION

Team registration will be held on Thursday, March 2, from 8:00 to 17:00 at Racing Office. It is located in Hotel Listel Inawashiro, on 2nd floor.

3. ACCOMMODATION

Accommodation for athlete and officials is provided at various hotels at Inawashiro. All teams must check in at Reception and get an accommodation voucher.

As per the FIS Rule on accommodation, each participant will be pay the Organizing Committee the Japanese YEN equivalent of CHF45 (JPYen3,917_) per day.
Accommodation will be provided as follows:

- For the night of March 2nd to 5th , 2006 inclusive (4 nights)

At the time of check in a major credit card will be required to cover all incidentals.
Each team will be held responsible for any damage incurred during your stay.
All attempts are being made for double occupancy.

4. MEALS

Breakfast and dinner will be provided, commencing with dinner on Thursday, March 2nd, and concluding with breakfast on Monday, March 6th.

5. GROUND TRANSPORTATION AIRPORT TO INAWASHIRO NEW IMPORTANT

The Organizing Committee chartered the bus (World Cup Bus) for competitors and coaches transporting from **Sendai International airport** to Inawashiro (on Thursday, March 2nd), Inawashiro to Narita airport (on Monday, March 6th), JPY5,000 per person of charge.

It will take about 2 hours from Sendai airport. We would recommend to take the above special chartered bus, because sometimes it might be quite trouble some to find the suitable communication at Sendai for Inawashiro. The transportation schedule of bus is **only Thursday, March 2nd**. So, please arrange to book the flight at Sendai (**OZ-152 from Seoul**).

Do a reservation for the airplane of Fukushima airport from Seoul (**OZ-156**), when you can't reserve the flight at Sendai.

When it arrived except for these two airports, arrange it in your own team, and come to Inawashiro, because we don't arrange it.

Regarding the Departure time of bus for Inawashiro is not fixed. Please meet us at Sendai airport lobby.

6. BIBS

All competitors must wear bibs during all official training, competition and award ceremonies.

7. ACCIDENT INSURANCE

Each competitor must have his/her own medical insurance. The Organizing Committee, sponsors, suppliers, their agents, Inawashiro, FIS and Ski Association of Japan decline any responsibility for accidents, damaged or lost equipment and second and third party claims during the event.

8. LIABILITY

All athletes, official and other members of the National Association who attend and participate in the event shall do so at their own risk. The Organizing Committee, Inawashiro, the Ski Association of Japan, sponsors and suppliers, their agents, employees and volunteers shall not be responsible for any losses or injuries incurred or suffered by any athletes, official or other person in conjunction with the organizing or staging of the event.

All participants are urged not to be negligent in safeguarding their personal belongings at all times. The aforementioned parties will take no responsibility for missing belongings.

9. MEDICAL AND DOPING

Anti-doping control may be conducted for each event and gender.

10. MONEY EXCHANGE

It is recommended to exchange all money at the Sendai airport. There are not money exchanges at hotels in Inawashiro.
