1. Introduction

Davos is organizing the AERIALS FIS WORLD CUP - DAVOS 2006. This competition, for ladies and men, will be held under FIS rules and Freestyle Skiing World Cup. All national FIS-affiliated associations are invited to compete.

According to the international calendar of the FIS, the competition will take place on the 3rd of March 06 and will follow the official programme. The Organizing Committee reserves the right to modify the timetable and the arranged place of the event depending on the snow conditions or on the decision of the jury.

The final entry of the competitors with their names must be given by the team coach to the competition secretary no later than two hours before the draw of the competition.

4. Registration

Team registration will take place daily starting on 27th of February, from 12.00 to 18.00h, at the Race Office located at the bottom station of the Jakobshorn Gondola, close to the competition area.

5. Accommodation

Accommodation for athletes and officials is provided at various hotels in Davos. Hotel assignment will be confirmed upon arrival at the Race office in Davos. All teams must first register at the Race office and get an accommodation voucher before heading to the assigned hotel.

As per the FIS Rule on accommodation and half pension, each participant will pay the Organizing Committee 45 Swiss francs per day based on double occupancy.

Accommodations will be provided as follows: 5 nights, arriving on Monday, Feb. 27th and departing on Saturday, March 4th 2006.

At the time of check-in at your hotel, a fully refundable damage deposit charged to a major credit card will be required (a credit card is required). Each National Association (Team) will be held responsible for any damage incurred during its stay.

All competitors must wear bibs during all official trainings, competition and award ceremonies. 20.00 Euro deposit per bib will be asked upon registration.

Each competitor must have his/her own medical insurance. The Organizing Committee, sponsors, suppliers, their agents, Davos, the FIS and the Swiss Ski association decline any responsibility for accidents, damaged or lost equipment and second and third party claims during the event.
