This information must be received by the Organizing Committee not later than Wednesday, December 14, 2005 (Announcement of Team Size); definitive registration by name has to be not later than Friday, December 30, 2005. Please use the official entry form (ICR art. 215).

2. Registration

Team registration will take place on Saturday, January 7, 2006 from 08.00 am. to 09.00 pm. at the Accreditation Office in the "Kreischberg - Halle" (close to Kreischberg). All fees and deposits must be paid upon registration – cash or credit card! Official departure day: Tuesday, January 10, 2006.

3. Accommodation

According to the FIS Rule on accommodation and half board, each participant will pay CHF 50/day/person directly to the OC World Cup Kreischberg / Murau – race office. Accommodation at FIS rate will be provided for the nights of January 7, to January 10, 2006. Each team will be held responsible for any damage incurred during the stay. Any kind of extras like phone, laundry, minibar and pay-TV must be paid by the teams or athletes. Reservations are only accepted with the Reservation Form – Teams!









4. Transportation

Teams are responsible for their own transportation.

5. Meals

Breakfast and dinner will be provided, starting with dinner on Saturday, January 7, 2006 and ending with breakfast on Tuesday 10, January 2006.

6. Bibs

All competitors must wear bibs during all official training, competition and award ceremonies.

7. Accident Insurance

Each competitor must have his / her own medical insurance. The Organizing Committee, sponsors, suppliers, their agents, the OC Kreischberg, the FIS and the Austrian Ski Federation decline any responsibility for accidents, damaged or lost equipment and second and third party claims during the event. All athletes must have previously signed the "FIS Athletes Declaration" form in order to register.

8. Liability

All athletes, officials and members of the National Association who attend and participate in the event shall do so at their own risk. The Organizing Committee Kreischberg, the Austrian Ski Federation, sponsors and suppliers, their agents, employees and volunteers shall not be responsible for any losses or injuries incurred or suffered by any athlete, official or other person in conjunction with the organizing or staging of the event.
