Accommodation

As per the FIS Rule on accommodation and half-board, each participant will pay CHF 50.00 per day/person directly at the hotel

After the deadline for team entries Wednesday, December 28th, 2005 this rate can't be guaranteed anymore.

Each team will be held responsible for any damage incurred during the stay. Any kind of extras must be paid by the teams or athletes. "No Shows" become charged to the National Associations directly at the Hotel.

**Attention: The official arrival day is Thursday, 26.01.2006.
The official reserve day or official departure day is scheduled for Sunday, 29.01.2006.**

Meals

According to the FIS Rules breakfast and dinner will be provided at the team hotels. For the day of the race there will be a lunch coupon per person. The lunch coupons can only be received at the Race Office. The lunch will be given at the snack-bar in the finish area.

Registration/Race Office

Team registration will take place daily starting on Friday, January 27th, 2006 at the Race Office, which is located at the Citizen and Town House, Fichtenweg 10 in Winterberg

The Race Office is open Friday from 8.00 (8.00 AM) to 12.00 h (12.00 AM) and from 15.00 (3.00 PM) to 19.30 h (7.30 PM) and Saturday from 9.00 (9.00 AM) to 22.00 h (10.00 PM).

Race venue/Transportation:

The venue, at Winterberg Ski Resort, is located about 5 car-minutes from the village of "Winterberg". Every Team is responsible for their own transport.





Bibs

The competitors must wear bibs during the official training, competition and award ceremonies.

Liability

All athletes, officials and other representatives of National Associations will attend at their own risk.

The organizer declines any liability for damages or injuries of athletes, officials or any other persons.
