# 2. Registration

Team registration will start Saturday, October 8th, from 10.00 to 21.00 at the Accreditation Office in the MSR (Marine Simulation Rotterdam) building.

#### 3. Accommodation

As per the FIS Rule on accommodation and half board, each participant will pay CHF 50/day/person directly to the OC World Cup Rotterdam.

Accommodation at FIS rate will be provided for two nights of October 08th to October 10th, 2005.

Each team will be held responsible for any damage incurred during the stay.

#### 4. Transportation

Teams are responsible for their own transportation.





#### 5. Meals

Breakfast, lunch and dinner will be provided, starting with dinner on Saturday October 8<sup>th</sup> in the hotel. Also breakfast will be in the hotel on Sunday the 9<sup>th</sup> and Monday the 10<sup>th</sup>.

At Sunday the 9<sup>th</sup> lunch and dinner will be organized at the event site.

#### 6. Bibs

All competitors must wear bibs during all official training, competition and award ceremonies.

#### 7. Accident Insurance

Each competitor must have his/her own medical insurance. The Organizing Committee, sponsors, suppliers, their agents, the OC Rotterdam, the FIS and the Netherlands Ski Federation decline any responsibility for accidents, damaged or lost equipment and second and third party claims during the event.

# 8. Liability

All athletes, officials and members of the National Association who attend and participate in the event shall do so at their own risk. The Organizing Committee, the Netherlands Ski Federation, sponsors and suppliers, their agents, employees and volunteers shall not be responsible for any losses or injuries incurred or suffered by any athlete, official or other person in conjunction with the organising or staging of the event.
