## Rules

### ARTICLE 1

Saas-Fee is organizing an international competition, Nokia Snowboard FIS World Cup Halfpipe & Snowboardcross.

### ARTICLE 2

This competition, for both women and men, will be held under FIS rules. At the Snowboard World Cup all national FIS-affiliated associations are invited to compete.

### ARTICLE 3

According to the international calendar of the FIS, the competition will take place from October 20<sup>th</sup> until October 23<sup>th</sup>, 2005 and will follow the official programme.

### ARTICLE 4

The Organizing Committee reserves the right to modify the timetable and the arranged place of the event depending on the snow conditions or on the decision of the jury.



## General Information Registration

The final entry of the competitors with their names must be given by the team coach to the competition secretary no later than two hours before the draw of the competition.

### 2. Registration

## **Accommodation**

### **1. Accommodation**

As per the FIS Rule on accommodation and half board, each participant will pay CHF 50.-/day/person directly at the hotel. Accommodation at the FIS rate will be provided only for the nights of October 17<sup>th</sup> to October 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2005.

Each team will be held responsible for any damage incurred during your stay. Any kind of extras like phone, laundry, minibar, pay-tv, etc. must be paid by the teams or athletes.

### **2. Transportation**

Saas-Fee is car free. Transportation can be done by electrical Taxis. Please call a taxi-Company from the parking lot (Free of charge). Teams are responsible for their own transportation. Most of the hotels provide a luggage pick up service. You can also call the hotels free of charge from the parking lot.



## **Competition**

### **1. BIBS**

All competitors must wear bibs during all official training, competition and award ceremonies.

### **2. Accident Insurance**

Each competitor must have his/her own medical insurance. The Organizing Committee, sponsors, suppliers, their agents, Saas-Fee, the FIS and the Swiss Ski association decline any responsibility for accidents, damaged or lost equipment and second and third party claims during the event.

### **3. Liability**

All athletes, officials and members of the National Associations who attend and participate in the event shall do so at their own risk. The Organizing Committee, the Swiss Ski Association, sponsors and suppliers, their agents, employees and volunteers shall not be responsible for any losses or injuries incurred or suffered by any athlete, official or other person in conjunction with the organizing or staging of the event.
