### 3. REGISTRATION:

Team registration and lodging check-in, will take place at Competition Headquarters, which will be located at The Lodges at Deer Valley in Snow Park Village, the base area of Deer Valley, (2900 Deer Valley Drive East). Team registration/lodging check-in will take place daily **beginning on Monday, January 28<sup>th</sup>, from 12:00 p.m. – 8:00 p.m.**

***All fees and deposits must be paid upon registration.***

To be eligible for participation in the 2008 Freestyle FIS World Cup each competitor must be a citizen of a country from the National Ski Association, with a license and prove this with a valid passport.

### 4. ACCOMMODATIONS:

Accommodations for athletes and officials are provided at various condominiums in the Snow Park Village, the base area of Deer Valley Resort. Condominium assignment will be confirmed upon arrival at the Competition Headquarters. Each condominium will have a fully equipped kitchen.

As per the FIS Rule 5.1 on accommodation, food and transportation, the venue will collect 15-CHF per person with no meal plan. **Note: Charges apply to all persons listed on the Team Selection Form as of January 18, 2007. Teams will be charged for all non-attendees listed on the Team Selection Form.** Payment ***must*** be made at time of check-in via cash or credit card only.

Accommodations will be provided beginning the night of Monday, January 28, with the exception of Ski Cross lodging beginning the night of Tuesday, January 29, and all departing the morning of Sunday, February 3, 2008.

At the time of check-in, **a major credit card will be required** to cover all incidentals. Each team will be held responsible for any damage incurred during their stay.

### 5. TRANSPORTATION:

Teams will be responsible for their own transportation to and from Deer Valley Resort and the Salt Lake City International Airport. Park City Transportation is offering airport shuttles at a discounted rate of \$59.00 US dollars per person/round trip for advanced bookings.
