The French Ski Federation and the organising committee of the F.I.S Freestyle Ski World Cup 2007 in “Les Contamines-Montjoie” are pleased to invite your national team to take part to this event.

To help you with the preparation of your team’s visit, **please read carefully all the information below.**

1 The programme:

You will find enclosed the official programme of the event according to the FIS calendar. The organising committee (OC) reserves the right to change the schedule of the events from those published in the programme, if necessary and with the jury of competition decision.

2 Arrival and organising centre:

Please note that the accommodation service of the Tourist Office is the only place for arrivals, check in and departure. This place is located in the Tourist Office at the door “Centrale de Réservation”.
Arrivals:

- SKICROSS: From 15.00 to 19.00 Thursday 10th
- HALF PIPE: From 16.00 to 20.00 Friday 11th

This office is open from 8.30 to 12.00 and from 14.00 to 19.00 during the event.

Each official and competitor will receive an accreditation card (with an identity photo provided from your side) from the OC providing free access to the competition site. The card must be worn at all time and showed if required.

The race office and Team captains meeting are located in the “Espace Animation” 150 m up to the Tourist Office.

3 Entries

According to the FIS rules, all national association affiliated with the FIS are invited to compete. Entries will be accepted from National Ski Association in accordance with the FIS quota and rules and must be submitted to the Organising Committee.

First sheet sended: we need your right number of racer expected to compete, NOT YOUR QUOTA

4 Bibs:

All competitors must wear their bibs during all official training, competition, flowers and awards ceremony after the race. A refundable 20€ deposit per bib will be charged upon registration.

5 Insurance/ Accident:

Every competitor and official must have their own medical insurance. All athletes, officials and other members of their National Association who attend to participate in the event shall do so at their own risk. The organising committee declines any responsibility for accidents, damaged equipment during the event.

6 Accommodation:

Accommodation for athletes and officials is provided at various apartments and hotels in Les Contamines-Montjoie and in the area with half board vouchers.

- **Skicross:** 3 nights from Thursday 10th to Sunday 13th. The FIS rate will be applied to all competitors and officials in the FIS quota.
- **Half pipe:** 3 nights from Friday 11th to Monday 14th. The FIS rate will be applied only for the 24 men and 12 women qualified for the finals.

At the time of check in, each coach **will pay the totality of the accommodation expenses and a fully refundable damage deposit charged to a major credit card will be required** (a credit card is mandatory). Each National association will be held responsible for any damage incurred during its stay. Skis and grooming equipment as well as wax must be stored in room and place provided by hotel or Organising Committee.

These conditions will be applied to the members registered on the entry form returned to the OC before December 13th. A completed rooming list must be sent before December 23rd 2007 with any wishes about room and place sharing.

For those who want a fourth night, the same rate could be applied if the request is sent not later than December 23rd otherwise it could not be guaranteed.

**Any modification after January 4th will occur
cancellation fees and extra booking could not be guaranteed at the FIS rate.**
