e.on Ruhrgas FIS World Cup Ski Jumping

Anders Jacobsen wins second competition in Liberec (CZE) Feb, 9th 2008/hn

Anders Jacobsen from Norway won the second of two e.on Ruhrgas FIS World Cup Ski Jumping competitions in Liberec (CZE) today. Jacobsen received 262,3 points for his jumps to 128,5 and 130 meters. On the second place finished Gregor Schlierenzauer from Austria with jumps to 127 and 128,5 meters (258.4 points) ahead of Martin Koch from Austria who received 258.2 points (132,5 and 124 meters).

## Statements:

Anders Jacobsen: "For me it was the first time here and I really liked the hill and the surroundings. I didn't feel so good yesterday but today I felt great and I am really happy about my victory."

Martin Koch: It was the first time I jumped on this hill and I really like it very much. The 3<sup>rd</sup> place is really great. I had good jumps here during the weekend although but the last one was not so good. It was a very good competition today.

Gregor Schlierenzauer: "I really like the hill and I am already looking forward to the next year's World Championships. I felt good today and enjoyed the competition."

Thomas Morgenstern, who finished on the 8th place today is still in a clear lead in the e.on Ruhrgas FIS World Cup Ski Jumping overall with a total of 1.587 points, that is 588 points ahead of Gregor Schlierenzauer (999) and 647 points ahead of Janne Ahonen (940).
