

FIS Competition Facts Ski Jumping COC



Mazoch's comeback and an Austrian show of strength at the COC Weekend in Pragelato (ITA)

Manuel Fettner on saturday and Thomas Thurnbichler on sunday, both from Austria, were the winners at the first two COC competitions of this winter in Pragelato (ITA).

On saturday Fettner achieved 276,2 points for jumps up to 137,5 and 136,5 meters,

on sunday 251,2 points (138/123,5 meters) were enough for Thomas Thurnbichler to win.

Former World Cup winner Jakub Janda finished second on both days. Janda from Czech Republik decided to start in Italy because he was not in a good shape before the World Cup opening weekend in Kuusamo (FIN).

After his succesfull start in the COC it now looks like Janda will participate in the e.on Ruhrgas FIS World Cup Ski Jumping in Trondheim (NOR) next weekend.

Roland Müller (AUT) on saturday and local Andrea Morassi (ITA) on sunday finished third.

None of the winners but Czech Jumper Jan Mazoch was the man of the weekend as it was Mazoch's comeback after his heavy fall in Zakopane during the World Cup competition on the 20th january 2007. Mazoch worked hard after his serious head injouries and could now finish as 15th on Saturday and 51th on Sunday.

Next COC Competitions will be held in Rovaniemi (FIN) 12th and 13th december.
