# e.on Ruhrgas FIS World Cup Ski Jumping

## 56<sup>th</sup> Jack Wolfskin Four-Hill Tournament:

Ahonen first ever to take 5 wins in the Four-Hill Tournament overall

Janne Ahonen from Finland has won the fourth and last competition of the 56<sup>th</sup> Jack Wolfskin Four-Hill

Tournament in Bischofshofen (AUT) today.

Tournament in Bischofshofen (AUT) today. With his second win in the 56<sup>th</sup> Tournament Ahonen achieved his 5<sup>th</sup> overall win in the Four-Hill Tournament. No athlete has made 5 overall wins in history of the Four-Hill-Tournament before.

Janne Ahonen (251.6 points / 126 and 136 meters) won after a dramatic final round in Bischofshofen ahead of Anders Bardal from Norway (243.6 points / 132.5 and 124.5 meters) and Austrian Thomas Morgenstern 242.7 points / 121 and 135.5 meters).

Thomas Morgenstern is still in a clear lead in the e.on Ruhrgas FIS World Cup Ski Jumping overall with 940 points ahead of Gregor Schlierenzauer (654 points) and now Janne Ahonen from Finland (615 points).

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#### Statements:

Simon Ammann: "A very difficult slope. It was not easy to find the right mix to make a good jump. The copmetition had to be stopped. I cannot understand why they continued."

Tom Hilde: "A very bad competition. But a better jump was possible for me. The worse conditions were not the reason form my dissapointing result. I felt not so bad as the jump looked like. Janne Ahonen showed what is possible with these conditions."

Wolfgang Loitzl: "It was difficult today. With 2 Km/h slower you cannot win. I am not used to such a situation. I had no chance. I had needed a fabulous jump, but it did not come. All in all it was no fair competition today."

Andreas Küttel: "I never found the feeling in my jumps today. These conditions can happen sometimes. It is not good that it ist he last competition."

Arthur Pauli: "Run two was ok. The slope was very difficult. The hole tournament was ok for me. Ski jumping is a outdoor sport. So the weather plays an important role."

Gregor Schlierenzauer: "Not to reach the final in my home competition is very sad. I also had a problem with my ski. I should not be today. But life goes on, I am young and I will be part of a lot of tournaments."

Michael Neumayer: "In the first run I was too late. I reached the final. The first run was strange. The slope was very slow. So the best athlets had no good conditions. But this is ski jumping, good for me and bad fort he others. It can be brutal. I am very satisfied for my overall result. But I would be also happy about the sixth place."

Adam Malysz: "Janne is simply the best. He has the routine you need for winning big titels. I was relaxed too, but not satisfied at all after the four competitions. Next year I will attac and win the tournament."

Martin Koch: "At the hill nearly the same conditions for everyone, that I had not expected. Overall I am not satisfied. I could have made it much better. After the dissapointment yesterday I managed it better today. Morgi had not the luck he needed and showed a normal jump. It is sad, but the weather made the result of the tournament."

Martin Schmitt: "It was a really good result for me. I am satisfied. After a long time closed to the podium, that is good. I have to train further and try to stabil my jumps. With the first round today Michi had the chance to reach a very good afterall position. Fantastic."

Janne Ahonen: "What schould I say. I am so happy about this victory. After Oberstdorf it seemed to be nearly impossible, but now I manged it. I can not realize yet what I have reached."

Thomas Morgenstern: "It was a difficult competition, with a difficult slope. I have done my very best. The 2. run motivates me. I try to reach the overall world cup. You only can make one thing with 100 percent. The 4 hill tournament you cannot win easily. But the second place satisfied me at all."







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Anders Bardal: "I was very nervous. I was never im my career the last man jumping. And I heared that Janne made a really good jump, that makes me even more nervous. But with the second place I am totally satisfied."
