e.on Ruhrgas FIS World Cup Ski Jumping

Norwegian Björn. Einar Romoeren wins in Willingen (GER) Feb, 17th 2008/hn

After his win with the Norwegian team yesterday, Björn-Einar Romoeren won the individual e.on Ruhrgas FIS World Cup Ski Jumping competition in Willingen today.

Romeren received 286.6 points for jumps to 142 and 147.5 meters. On the second place finished Jernej Damjan from Slovenia (143 and 143.5 meters / 282.2 points) ahead of Anders Bardal from Norway (142 and 143.5 points / 279.9 points)

Statements

Jernej Damjan (SLO):

"I like the hill here and I am really happy about my two great jumps today. Now I am looking forward to the ski flying event in Oberstdorf next weekend."

Anders Bardal (NOR):

"I have constantly progressed since Friday Congratulations Thomas Morgenstern. Despite our great performance here I think the Austrian team is the main contenders for the titles next weekend anyway. "Bjoern Einar Romoeren (NOR):

"It is great to jump here in front of this nice crowd. It was a good World Cup for both our team and for me. Yet, I feel quite sick and hope to recover quickly to be in good shape for next weekend's great highlight.

Morgenstern claims e.on Ruhrgas FIS World Cup Ski Jumping overall

Six competitions before the end of the season Thomas Morgenstern already won the overall 2007/2008. Morgenstern leads with 1632 points that is 601 points ahead of second Gregor Schlierenzauer (1031 points). On the third place is Janne Ahonen from Finland (969 points)
