



COC in Ramsau: Loitzl and Fettner win / only Austrians on the podium

(The Ramsau competitions replaced the Bischofshofen races)

Wolfgang Loitzl and Manuel Fettner came off as the winners of the COC weekend in Ramsau (AUT)

On Saturday Wolfgang Loitzl (247.5 points / 96.5 and 92.5 meters) won ahead of Bastian Kaltenboeck (246 points / 93.5 and 93.5 meters) and Manuel Fettner (241 points / 91.5 and 94.5 meters) all from Austria.

The second Competition on Sunday was won by Manuel Fettner (257.5 points / 96.5 and 96 meters) ahead of Wolfgang Loitzl (254 points / 95.5 and 96 meters) and Bastian Kaltenboeck (250 points / 94.5 and 95.5 meters).
