#### **Janne Ahonen wins second competition in Kuopio**

**March, 4th 2008/hn**

Janne Ahonen won the e.on Ruhrgas FIS World Cup Ski Jumping competition in Kuopio (FIN) today.

Ahonen received 248.3 points for his 122.5 and 126 meter jumps.

On the second place finished Anders Bardal from Norway (240.4 points / 117.5 and 128 meters) ahead of Tom Hilde from Norway ( 237.2 points / 121.5 and 122.5 meters)

Statement winner:

**.Janne Ahonen (FIN):** "Pujio is still a bad name although I'm very happy and satisfied with my jumps and the victory Snow fall made jumping a bit difficult but sometimes I like to jump on difficult circumstances".

Janne Happonen (378.9 points) now leads in the Nordic Tournament overall ahead of Janne Ahonen (378.7 points) with the minimal advance of 0,2 points after two competitions.

Third is Gregor Schlierenzauer from Austria (374.4 points), 4,6 points behind of Happonen.

The Nordic Tournament continues on Friday in Lillehammer, Norway.
