



COC in Trondheim (NOR): Kaltenboeck wins

Austrian Bastian Kaltenboeck won the first of two COC competitions in Trondheim (NOR) today. Kaltenboeck received 267.1 points for his jumps to 132.5 and 129.5 meters. On the second place finished Henning Stensrud from Norway (260.2 points / 129.5 and 127 meters) ahead of Roar Ljøekelsoey (NOR) 252.2 points/126.5 and 125 meters.

Statements

Bastian Kaltenboeck:

"I am really happy about the win of this competition. I was in bad shape in Vancouver because of the jet-lag. Here in Trondheim I feel much more relaxed. The only problem was that I lost my luggage on the way from Vancouver to Trondheim. I only got one round of training because of that. That doesn't matter now since I won the competition today".

Henning Stensrud:

"I have never won a COC competition before, so my plan was to win today. I almost did it. The level is high in COC too, so am really happy to be on second place. I will go for the first place tomorrow".

Roar Ljøekelsøy:

"It's the first time I compete in the Continental Cup, so I'm happy to be on third place. I didn't jump very well in the training and the trial rounds, but I did well in the competition. I will try to relax more tomorrow".

Stefan Thurnbichler (971 points) is still in the lead in the COC overall ranking ahead of Bastian Kaltenboeck (841 points). Balthasar Schneider (AUT) is on the third place (580 points).

Next COC Competition will be held in Trondheim (NOR) tomorrow, 09.03.2008.
