



Second COC in Trondheim (NOR): Ljoekelsoey wins

Norwegian Roar Ljoekelsoey won the second of two COC competitions in Trondheim (NOR) today. Ljoekelsoey received 268.6 points for his jumps to 125.5 and 134 meters. On the second place finished yesterdays winner Bastian Kaltenboeck from Austria (259.9 points / 125.5 and 129.5 meters) ahead of Henning Stensrud from Norway (251.4 points/122.5 and 130.5 meters).

Statements

Roar Ljøekelsøy:

"It felt really good to win today. I am very satisfied with 134 meters and 20 points from one of the judges in the second round. The results in Holmenkollen will determine whether I will be on the team to Planica or not. I will take a break after the national championship in april, before I decide whether to continue next season or not".

Bastian Kaltenboeck:

"I am very satisfied with this weekend in Granåsen. I was the best yesterday, but Roar was very good today, so it was fair that he got the first price".

Henning Stensrud:

"I am fairly satisfied with my jumping this weekend. It was very nice in Granåsen, the track was perfect and the preparation of the hill was very good. Everything seemed to be under control. You can tell Mika that I would like to be on the team to Planica next weekend".

Stefan Thurnbichler (1007 points) is still in the lead in the COC overall ranking ahead of Bastian Kaltenboeck (921 points). Balthasar Schneider (AUT) is on the third place (580 points).
