

COC in Vikersund (NOR): Kaltenboeck wins

Austrian Bastian Kaltenboek won the first of two COC competitions in Vikersund (NOR) today. Kaltenboeck received 263 points for his jumps to 96.5 and 99 meters on the Vikersund HS 100 hill. On the second place finished Lars Bystoel from Norway (262.5 points / 98.5 and 97.5 meters) ahead of Martin Cikl (CZE) (249.5 points / 92 and 97.5 meters).

Statements

Bastian Kaltenboeck (AUT):

I'm really happy to win here in Vikersund today, what else can I ask for?".

Lars Bystoel (NOR)

"I hoped that I could keep my place at the top of the list for the second round as well, but unfortunately that didn't work".

Martin Cikl (CZE)

"I was really thrilled after his great second jump" (his second jump took Cikl from place ten after the first round to the podium.

Stefan Thurnbichler (1057 points) is still in the lead in the COC overall ranking ahead of Bastian Kaltenboeck (1021 points). Balthasar Schneider (AUT) is on the third place (580 points).
