2. ACCOMMODATION

Teams will be lodged in hotels - availability permitting - with half board at FIS rate (based on double rooms) from **Sunday evening 11 Jan. until the 14th January.** These conditions will be applied to the members registered on the entry form only, which has to be returned to the Organizing Committee **before Monday 15th December 2008**.

3. ARRIVAL / REGISTRATION

Team registration will take place at the Tourist Office, located in the area 'Flaine Forum', on Sunday, January 11th 2009, from 10h00am – 08h00pm.

All fees and deposits must be paid upon registration.

To be eligible for participation in the 2009 Freestyle FIS World Cup each competitor must be a citizen of a country from the National Ski Association, with a license and prove this with a valid passport.







4. RACE CENTRE

The team registration desk, the race office, Team Captains' meeting room as well as the press centre will be located at the hall 'Auditorium Eric & Sylvie Boissonnas' in the area 'Flaine Forêt'.

5. MEDICAL AND DOPING:

Anti-doping control may be conducted for each gender.

6. INSURANCE / LIABILITY:

Each competitor must have his/her own medical insurance. The Organizing Committee sponsors, suppliers, their agents, the FIS and the French National Ski Federation decline any responsibility for accidents, damaged or lost equipment and second and third party claims during the event.

All athletes, officials and members of the National Associations who attend and participate in the event shall do so at their own risk. The Organizing Committee, sponsors and suppliers, their agents, employees and volunteers shall not be responsible for any losses or injuries incurred or suffered by any athlete, official or other person in conjunction with the organizing or staging of the event.
