#### 1. Registration

Team registration will take place daily starting Wednesday, September 3<sup>rd</sup>, from 08.00 to 20.00 at Event HQ at Grand Mercure Oakridge Resort, in Wanaka.

#### 2. Accommodation

Accommodation for teams and officials will be provided at the Grand Mercure Oakridge Resort. As per the FIS Rule on accommodation and half board, each participant will pay CHF50 (NZ\$65) per person per night directly at Grand Mercure Oakridge Resort. Accommodation at the FIS rate will be provided only for the nights of September 3<sup>rd</sup> to 7<sup>th</sup>, 2008.

Payment must be made at check-in by cash or credit card only. Each team will be held responsible for any damage incurred during your stay. Incidentals such as telephone, laundry have to be paid by the teams or athletes themselves.

Teams must forward their team accommodation requests by the Team Size Entry Form by July 18<sup>th</sup> (see above). To ensure bed availability, teams must confirm their accommodation by July 25<sup>th</sup>.

Teams are welcome to book their own accommodation but the organising committee will not subsidise any accommodation. It will be up to the individual teams to book accommodation at Grand Mercure Oakridge Resort before the evenings of September  $3^{rd}$  or after September  $7^{th}$ .
