Rules

ARTICLE 1

Kreischberg/Murau is organizing the FIS Telemark World Championships 2009.

ARTICLE 2

This competition, for both women and men, will be held under FIS rules. At the Telemark World Championships all national FIS – affiliated associations are invited to compete.

The number of competitors per nation is max. 10 per gender and discipline.

ARTICLE 3

According to the international calendar of the FIS, the competition will take place from January, 21st to 24th, 2009 and will follow the official programme.

ARTICLE 4

The Organizing Committee reserves the right to modify the timetable and the arranged place of the event depending on the snow conditions or on the decision of the jury.

General Information Registration

1. Entries and important forms

Entries will be accepted from National Ski Associations accordance with the FIS rules for the FIS Telemark World Championships.

Deadline for entries: December, 15th, 2008

The final entry of the competitors with their names must be given by the team coach to the race secretary no later than two hours before the draw of the competition.

2. Registration

Team registration will take place starting at January, 20th, 2009 in the "Kreischberg Hall", close to the lift station, follow the signs. No registration without valid FIS-code.

1. Accommodation

As per the FIS Rule on lift ticket, accommodation and full board, each participant will pay € 38.- /day/person.

Accommodation at this rate will be provided for the period of January, 20th, to 24th, 2009, and only to those teams who made their <u>registration before December</u>, 15th.

Each team will be held responsible for any damage incurred during your stay. Any kind of extras like phone, laundry, minibar, pay-tv, etc. must be paid by the teams or athletes.

2. Transportation

Teams are responsible for their own transportation.

<u>From South/West</u>: Udine/Tarvisio, A2 Villach – Klagenfurt, exit B317 St. Veit, Scheifling, follow signs Murau; Distances: Udine 230 km, Klagenfurt 90 km

<u>From East</u>: Vienna, A2 till exit Seebenstein/Semmering, S6 Bruck, S36 Judenburg, B317

Scheifling, B96 Murau; Distance: Vienna 250 km

Airports: Vienna 250 km, Graz 150 km, Klagenfurt 90 km, Salzburg 160 km

Rail connection: ÖBB station Unzmarkt 30 km

Competition

1. BIBS

All competitors must wear bibs during all inspection, official training, competition and award ceremonies.

2. Accident Insurance

Each competitor must have his/her own medical insurance. It will be necessary to show your evidence of medical and insurance cover.

The Organizing Committee, sponsors, suppliers, their agents, the FIS and the Austrian Ski association decline any responsibility for accidents, damaged or lost equipment and second and third party claims during the event.

3. Liability

All athletes, officials and members of the National Associations who attend and participate in the event shall do so at their own risk. The Organizing Committee, the Austrian Ski Association, sponsors and suppliers, their agents, employees and volunteers shall not be responsible for any losses or injuries incurred or suffered by any athlete, official or other person in conjunction with the organizing or staging of the event.
