REGISTRATION

Team registration will take place daily starting on the arrival day **Wednesday**, **November 11th 2009**, **from 9:00 am – 9:00 pm**, at the Race Office in the Hullu Poro (Crazy Reindeer) Conference Centre.

The registration requires all members of the team to be accredited in the Race Office. If the team members have been accredited prior to the Levi events, the old pictures can be used for the accreditation and one member of the team can collect the accreditations for the whole team.

ACCOMMODATIONS

Accommodation for athletes and officials is provided in the hotels located on the Ski area. All check-ins and rooms registration will take place at the hotels. The payments for accommodation and full pension are based on the FIS Rule.

The Organizing Committee has made preliminary reservations for all the Ski Federations also for the additional nights (starting from Monday 9th). However, we need to know how many rooms the team needs and how long you are planning to stay at Levi. (See the Room List Form attached.)

The price for the extra night is $85 \in$ / person in double room with full board. The teams are advised to accommodate the team members in double rooms because of the amount of rooms available. If team needs single rooms the price is $130 \in$ / room with full board for the extra nights.

All the payments have to be done directly to the payment office in race office – including also the EXTRA nights.

As checking out the teams have to use the voucher of paid accommodation to the hotel front desk in order to avoid any misunderstandings.

HELSINKI ACCOMMODATION

Teams overnighting in Helsinki have special rates available for the hotel Bonus Inn near airport. The reservation should be made with code **WORLD CUP LEVI 09**

TRANSPORTATION

FIS Travel is providing a charter connection to Kittilä from Zürich. All teams are advised to fly to Kittilä airport in order to use the free world cup airport shuttle.

Since the teams are provided a courtesy shuttle from the airport, they are asked to inform their arrival time in detail.

There is no need for transportation to the racecourse, since it's accessible by skis. For the officials there is a shuttle bus if needed.

The teams have availability to rent skis and boots for free from the Levi ski resort in order to avoid overweight - please send a list of names of those who need skis or boots to natalia.lahtela@skisport.fi

How to find the way

If your team arrives by car, here are some helpful directions how to find the way.

When crossing the state boarder from Sweden drive towards Tornio (road E4). The next bigger town is Rovaniemi (road 79) 123 km from Tornio. Then follow the signs to Kittilä (road 79), which is situated 150 km from Rovaniemi. The ski resort Levi (road 79) lies 18 km north from Kittilä.

RADIO PERMITS

Guidance concerning use of radio equipment in Finland at short term events

USAGE OF RADIO EQUIPMENT IN FINLAND

Every user of a radio transmitter (e.g. VHF and UHF radiophones) shall have a licence granted by the Finnish Communications Regulatory Authority (FICORA). PMR 446, LA, PR 27 or CB-telephones are not concerned, because their use is exempted from licencing provided that they are operating on the frequencies and with output powers according to the FICORA Regulation 15.

FICORA prescribes the frequencies to be used in the events and/or at the locations as specified in the licence. Using other frequencies than mentioned in the licence is prohibited.

LICENCE

The licence is granted on the basis of an application. An application form is available on the www-site of FICORA: http://www.ficora.fi/englanti/lomake/SHORTUSe.pdf. An application for a licence can be sent by post, by fax (+358 9 6966 410) or by e-mail at radiohallinto@ficora.fi.







PERIOD OF VALIDITY

The validity period of the licence is determined based on the information given in the application, however, the maximum period is 12 months. The licence can then be granted to cover different events for the same equipment. Locations, events and time periods shall be indicated in the application.

LICENCE FEE

The licence fee is $18.50 \in$ / mobile transmitter (year 2003). The fees for other radio transmitters can be found from the application form.

GRANTING OF A LICENCE AT THE EVENT

Exceptionally the licence can be granted at the place of the event for a maximum period of six months.
