1. ENTRIES

2. REGISTRATION

The registration will take place starting on Sunday, January 17th, from 09:00--21:00. For Sunday arrivals, teams are required to go directly to the **Blue Mountain Inn** located at the base of the resort (http://www.bluemountain.ca/lodging blue inn 1.htm).

If arriving on Monday or later, teams are requested to go directly to the Race Office located in the Grand Central Base Lodge (http://www.bluemountain.ca/conference_grand_central.htm-1). Race Office hours will be from 07:00 to 19:00 from Sunday, January 17 to Wednesday, January 20.

All fees must be paid upon registration by a designated team representative.

2. ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for participation in the 2010 Freestyle FIS World Cup, each competitor must be a citizen of the country from the National Ski Association. He or she must have FIS Code with and prove this with a valid passport. All fees and deposits must be paid in cash or credit card upon registration.








3. ACCOMMODATION

Accommodation and meal services will be at the Blue Mountain Inn, located at the base of the resort (http://www.bluemountain.ca/lodging blue inn 1.htm).

As per the FIS Rule on accommodation and half pension, each participant will pay the Organizing Committee the Cdn dollar in cash or credit card equivalent of 45 Swiss Francs per day (according to the FIS Rate as set in the World Cup Rules). Each coach has to pay his team accommodation expenses on arrival day. No reservation and no payment will be accepted from the racers. Each team will be responsible for any damage incurred during their stay.

4. TRANSPORTATION

Transportation from the Toronto airport to Blue Mountain located 7km west of Collingwood, Ontario, is the responsibility of the individual teams. The drive is approximately 2 hours, and directions can be found at: http://www.bluemountain.ca/directions/toronto airport.html









5. BIBS

All competitors must wear bibs during all official training, competition and award ceremonies. 20 Cdn dollars deposit per bib will be charged upon registration.

6. LIABILITY

All athletes, officials and other members of the National Associations or Federations who will attend and participate in the competitions shall do so at their own risk of any injuries or losses suffered or incurred during the competitions.

7. PROGRAM (changes may be possible)

January 17th: Sunday - Arrival of Teams January 18th: Monday - Official Training Day January 19th: Tuesday - Qualifying Day January 20th: Wednesday - Competition Day January 21st: Thursday – Departure Day

8. ACCIDENT INSURANCE

Every competitor must have his/her own medical insurance. In the case of accidents on courses during competition or training, the medical personnel from the Organizing Committee will be responsible for any medical decision to local hospital in co-operation with the respective team's medical personnel.

9. MEDICAL AND DOPING

Anti-doping control may be conducted for each event and gender.

Further information including official competition program, team captain's meeting and etc. will be informed later.
