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General Information Registration

1. ENTRIES

Entries will be accepted in accordance with the FIS quotas and rules. Please complete the enclosed Team Entry Form and remit to the Organizing Committee by fax, mail or email:

We ask each National Association to fill in the enclosed forms and send back to us as following:

19th November 2009: Announcement of team size (entry form and travelling form)

11th December 2009: Definitive registration

VISA

To travel to China, you are required to have a **Visa**. Once we have your team entries, we will send a letter of invitation **by name**. This invitation by name is the requirement when you make an application for a visa.

2. REGISTRATION

The registration will take place starting on Monday, December 14th, from 09:00--21:00 at the official hotel in Changchun City.

To be eligible for participation in the 2009 Freestyle FIS World Cup, each competitor must be a citizen of the country from the National Ski Association. He or she must have FIS Code with and prove this with a valid passport. All fees and deposits must be paid in cash or credit card upon registration.

3. ACCOMMODATION

As per the FIS Rule on accommodation and half pension, each participant will pay the Organizing Committee the US dollar or Euro in cash or credit card equivalent of 45 Swiss Francs per day (according to the FIS Rate as set in the World Cup Rules). **The accommodation will from the dinner of 14th to the breakfast of 21st December. For the teams which will take part in the Team Competition, the accommodation will from the dinner of 14th December to the breakfast of 23rd December.**

Each team will be responsible for any damage incurred during their stay.



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4. TRANSPORTATION

Please specify Changchun Airport as your point of arrival. The Organizing Committee will help to arrange the pick-up and drop off at the Changchun Airport.

50 USD per person is charged for the service of transportation.

5. BIBS

All competitors must wear bibs during all official training, competition and award ceremonies. 20 US dollars deposit per bib will be charged upon registration.

6. LIABILITY

All athletes, officials and other members of the National Associations or Federations who will attend and participate in the competitions shall do so at their own risk of any injuries or losses suffered or incurred during the competitions.

8. ACCIDENT INSURANCE

Every competitor must have his/her own medical insurance. In the case of accidents on courses during competition or training, the medical personnel from the Organizing Committee will be responsible for any medical decision to local hospital in co-operation with the respective team's medical personnel.

9. MEDICAL AND DOPING

Anti-doping control may be conducted for each event and gender.
