2. Rules

- The French freestyle Association and the Châtel Committee are organising an international Europa Cup Freestyle competition, part of the 2010 FIS Freestyle Europa Cup Circuit.
- The competition will be held under FIS rules and regulation for freestyle skiing.
- This competition is a moguls event for both men and women
- This competition will follow an official program that will be available to all participants
- The organizing committee reserve the right to change the schedule depending on snow conditions, weather or the decision of the competition jury

3. Entries

Entries will be accepted from the National ski Associations in accordance with the FIS qualification quotas and rules for the Freestyle Europa Cup.

4. Registration and means of payment

Organizing Centre:

The organizing centre is located in the Tourist Office.

Team registration will take place on Sunday 24/01/2010 from 14:30 to 18:00 and Monday 25/01/2010 from 09:00 to 12:00 at the "**Tourist Office**" from.

All fees and deposits must be paid upon registration in CHF or EUR and be paid in cash.

No cheques, no CB, or travellers cheques will be accepted.

5. Accommodation

6. Team Captains Meeting

The team Captains meeting will be held in the room called "la Musardière" located at the bottom of the lift of Super Châtel behind the Tourism Office of Châtel (Village centre).

7. Bibs and Helmets

It is necessary for all competitors to wear bibs and helmets through official training, competitions and award ceremony (bib only). A sanction will be given to any competitor who does not wear his/her bib. Each Team leader will be asked to deposit $10 \in$ per bib. Amount will be refunded by the end of the competitions when bibs are returned.

8. Liability

All Athletes, officials and other members of their National Association who attend and participate in the event shall do so at their own risk. The Organizing committee Châtel, the French Freestyle Ski Association, sponsors and suppliers, employees and volunteers shall not be held responsible to any losses or injuries incurred or suffered by nay athlete, official or other person in conjunction with the organisation or staging of the event. All participant are urged no to be negligent in safeguarding their personal belongings at all time.

9. Accident Insurance

Every competitor must be medically insured on her/his own. The Organizing Committee, Châtel, the FIS and the French Ski Association declines any responsibility for accidents, damaged equipment during the training and competitions.

10. Accident Protocol

In case of accidents on courses during the event, medical personnel from the Organizing Committee and Ski Patrol will be responsible for any medical decision or evacuation to local hospital.

11. Vehicle Parking

Vehicles can be parked close to the competition area during competition. A car accreditation will be given during registration to give access to the official race car park. The competition area can be reached by foot.
