#### 2. Rules

- The French freestyle Association and the Sauze Committee are organising an international Europa Cup Skicross competition, part of the 2009 FIS Freestyle Europa Cup Circuit.
- The competition will be held under FIS rules and regulation for freestyle skiing.
- This competition is a skicross event and is open to both men and women
- This competition will follow an official program that will be available to all participants
- The organizing committee reserve the right to change the schedule depending on snow conditions, weather or the decision of the competition jury

#### 3. Entries

Entries will be accepted from the National ski Associations in accordance with the FIS qualification quotas and rules for the Freestyle Europa Cup.

## 4. Registration and means of payment

# **Organizing Centre:**

The organizing centre is located in the Tourist Office.

Team registration will take place on sunday 24/01/2010t the "**Tourist Office**" from 14:30 to 18:00 and Monday 25/01/2010 from 9:00 to 12:00 at the tourist office All fees and deposits must be paid in CHF or EUR and has to be paid in cash.

No cheques, no CB, or travellers cheques will be accepted.

Price 30 € / athletes per person to participate in the competition.

#### 5. Accommodation

### 6. Team Captains Meeting

The team Captains meeting will be held in the "salle de presse" wich is located at the left of the entrance of the ski resort behind the Tourism Office (Village centre) next to the cinema

#### 7. Bibs and Helmets

It is necessary for all competitors to wear bibs and helmets during official training, competitions and award ceremony (bib only). A penalty will be given to any competitor who does not wear his/her bib. Each Team leader will be asked to deposit 10 € per bib. The deposit will be refunded at the end of the competitions when bibs are returned.

# 8. Liability

All competitors, officials and other members of their National Association who attend or participate in the event shall do so at their own risk. The Organizing committee Sauze, the French Freestyle Ski Association, sponsors and suppliers, employees and volunteers shall not be held responsible for any losses or injuries incurred or suffered by competitors, officials or other persons in conjunction with the organisation or staging of the event. All participants are urged not to be negligent in safeguarding their personal belongings at all times.

#### 9. Accident Insurance

Every competitor must be individually medically insured. The Organizing Committee, Le SAUZE SUPER-SAUZE, the FIS and the French Ski Association will not be held responsible for accidents, damaged equipment during the training and competitions.

#### 10. Accident Protocol

In case of an accident on the course during the event, medical personnel from the Organizing Committee and Ski Patrol will be responsible for any medical decision or evacuation to the local hospital.
