- 1.The German Ski Association (DSV) and the SC Wiesloch organizing committee are organizing a Freestyle Europa Cup Competition for the 2010 FIS Europa Cup circuit.
- 2.The Dates of the Competitions have been published in the International Calender of the FIS.
- 3. The Competitions will be held under FIS rules and regulations for Freestyle Skiing.
- 4.The Europa Cup Competition is composed of two events for both women und men: Moguls and Dual Moguls.
- 5. The organizing committee reserves the right to change the schedule or the place of the events from those stated in the programm, subjekt to the snow conditions or the decision of the competition jury.

Bibs

All competitors must wear their bibs during all official trainings, competitions and award ceremonies. Each team leader will be asked for € 20.- deposit per bib upon registration.

Skilift Tickets

Free of charge lift tickets for competitors and trainers will be provided on the days of competitions and official training days.

Award an Winning Ceremony

Award ceremonies will be right after each event in the finish area.

Insurance/Liability

All athletes, officials and other members of the national Ski associations who attend and participate in the competitions shall do so at their own risk. The organizing committee, the German Ski Association and the SC Wiesloch shall not be responsible for any any losses or injuries incurred or suffered by any athlete, official or other person in conjunction with the organisation or standing of the event. Every competitor must have his/her own medical insurance. The organizing committee, the German Ski Federation and the SC Wiesloch declines any responsibility for accidents, the damaged equipment and second if party claims during the competitions. All athletes must have previously signed the FIS Athletes Declaration form to be registered.
