Important information for the FIS Ski Cross-Country World Cup in Düsseldorf

Accommodation

As in previous years, all nations are accommodated in the **Hotel Tulip Inn.** The hotel is situated in the Düsseldorf ESPRIT-Arena and is only 5km away from the World Cup track. The competition track is easily reachable by roller ski via a signposted bicycle and footpath. We would like to point out that all hotel rooms are strictly non-smoking rooms and contravention of these terms will hold the perpetrator liable for special cleaning costs. Likewise with late checkouts, additional charges, payable directly in the hotel, will be calculated. The hotel requires a **credit card** before processing final reservations. Please send your credit card details, including number, banking institution and validity to baesken@allrounder.de as soon as possible.

One has the possibility of using the adjoining sport facilities, i.e. training hall and gym, for preparation for the competition, free of charge. Further information as to the sport facilities can be obtained directly from the hotel. Attached is the appropriate layout of these facilities.

Please note that training on the World Cup track is only possible as of Saturday December the 4^{th} 2010.

Seeded Groups

The organizers are liable for payment of accommodation for the ladies and men **seeded groups** for a maximum of 4 nights, from Thursday the December the 2nd through Monday December the 6th. This includes double room with full board (catering on competition days will take place at the track, breakfast and dinner at the hotel).

<u>Travel costs</u> for members of the seeded groups will be reimbursed to all participants on Friday, 03.12.2010 from 16h00 - 22h00 at the World Cup-Desk in the Hotel.

All further team members will receive a special offer of **90,00 Euro** (125 CHF), (per person, per night in double room incl. full board, i.e. meals in the Hotel and at the competition track), according to FIS regulations.

All extra costs, such as telephone, minibar, parking places etc, as well as cancellation costs for reserved, but not occupied rooms, must be according to FIS WC regulations, settled in full by athletes directly at the hotel before departure.

Please note that according to FIS regulations, nations are only provided with one single room per gender - additional single rooms can be booked at extra cost.

The mandatory reservation for the number of double and single rooms separated by gender, with arrival and departure times, is to be done either via the FIS online system, or faxed with the attached form to:

Shuttle service

The official World Cup airport is the "Düsseldorf International Airport (DUS)". A transfer per team, from the Düsseldorf International Airport to the hotel, is provided free of charge by the OC. Prerequisite for this is, provision of exact arrival and departure times, as well as **flight numbers** and **persons traveling**, in written form via email to baesken@allrounder.de or per Fax to +49-(0)2131-12 44 350, by November the 15th 2010 at the latest.

The shuttle service will be organized by SIXT, sponsored and supported by BMW. Please watch out for the **SIXT-Counter** in the arrival terminal after your landing.

A free of charge shuttle service will be provided between the Hotel and the World Cup track on the competition days. For other destinations, private transport must be individually organized at own cost.

Prize money

Prize monies after tax, according to FIS regulations for Ski Cross-country World Cups, will be transferred to the accounts provided to the FIS. Please have your account details readily available. Prize money will only be paid out, if the concerned person has participated at the official awards ceremony in the allrounder ARENA.

Team captain meeting

The first team captain meeting will take place on Friday, December 3rd 2010 at 17h00 in the "Plenarsaal" of the Düsseldorf town hall.

Accreditation

For the first time this year, accreditation for athletes will be done according to FIS regulations for seasonal accreditation, respectively the appropriate Bibs. Please always keep these with you at the competition and during transfer, as only this form of identification will allow access to the crew and athletes catering areas, as well as for the free shuttle service. Should this accreditation not be available or forgotten then in the case of an emergency, an auxiliary accreditation can be issued at the accreditation centre in the town hall.


