Dear Mr./Mrs. President, Dear Ski friends,


According to the decision of FIS the Union "Belarusian Skiing Union" has the right to host FIS Freestyle Ski World Cup Aerials competitions.

### **General Information Registration**

#### 1. ENTRIES

Entries will be accepted in accordance with the FIS quotas and rules. Please complete the enclosed Team Entry Form and remit to the Organizing Committee by fax or e-mail:

Entries will be accepted from National Ski Associations within the FIS quotas and World Cup rules and must be submitted to the Organizing Committee. Please complete the enclosed Preliminary Entry (Form 2), accommodation application (Form 3) and transportation request (Form 4) by January 20, 2011.

The **FINAL** (Form 1.) definitive registration (by name, confirmation of team size, arrival and departure dates) must be confirmed to the Organizing Committee **by February 11, 2011.** 

#### **VISA**

To travel to Belarus, you are required to have a **Visa**. Once we have your team entries, we will send a letter of invitation **by name**. This invitation by name is the requirement when you make an application for a visa. See visa application form attached.

#### 2. REGISTRATION

The registration will take place starting at the official hotel in Minsk **Monday, February 15th**, from 12:00-21:00









To be eligible for participation in the 2010/2011 FIS Freestyle Ski World Cup, each competitor must be a citizen of the country from the National Ski Association. He or she must have a FIS Code and prove it with a valid passport. All fees and deposits must be paid **in cash** upon registration.

#### 3. ACCOMMODATION

As per the FIS Rule for accommodation and half board, each participant will pay the Organizing Committee the US dollar or Euro in cash or credit card equivalent of 45 CHF per day (according to the FIS Rate as set in the World Cup Rules).

The accommodation will be provided from the dinner of 15<sup>th</sup> to the breakfast of 20<sup>th</sup> February.

Early arrivals and late departures are subject to availability and are not available at the FIS Rate. The hotel rates for early arrival and late departure are available upon request.

Each team will be responsible for any damage incurred during their stay.

#### 4. TRANSPORTATION

Please specify Minsk-2 Airport or Minsk Railway station as your point of arrival.

The Organizing Committee will help to arrange the transfer of teams from Minsk-2 Airport and Minsk Railway station and back.

25 USD per person is charged for the service of transportation (Minsk-2 Airport/ Minsk Railway station).

#### 5. BIBS

All competitors must wear bibs during all official training, competition and award ceremonies.

20 US dollars deposit per bib will be charged upon registration.









#### 6. LIABILITY

All athletes, officials and other members of the National Associations or Federations who will attend and participate in the competitions shall do so at their own risk of any injuries or losses suffered or incurred during the competitions.

#### 8. ACCIDENT INSURANCE

Every competitor must have his/her own medical insurance. In the case of accidents on

courses during competition or training, the medical personnel from the Organizing

Committee will be responsible for any medical decision in co-operation with the respective team's medical personnel.

#### 9. MEDICAL AND DOPING

Anti-doping control may be conducted for each event and gender.
