Basic Event Program:

The Ski Cross Showdown at RED consists of two FIS NorAm Ski Cross competitions for both Ladies and Men.

The competition will take place on Rico Racer run accessible by the Silverlode Quad Chairlift at the base of RED. The course is visible from RED's Day Lodge and the finish area is steps away from RED's slope-side lodging. Media and spectators can access the bottom of the course with a short walk up the slope.

Team Captains Meeting:

The First Meeting of the Team Captains will take place on Wed. March 9^{th} before training. The draw will take place at the second Team Captains meeting on Thurs. March 10^{th}

Bibs:

Numbered bibs will be distributed at registration with a \$20 refundable deposit immediately following the completion of the competition.

Statement of Medical Plan:

The Medical Plan will be outlined at the first Team Captain's meeting and copies will be available at this time. All incidents requiring medical attention will be directed and managed by RED's Pro Ski Patrol and medical doctor.









Statement of Liability:

All athletes, officials and other members of their National Association who attend and participate in the event shall do so at their own risk. The Organizing Committee, The Resort, the National Ski Association, sponsors and suppliers, their agents, employees and volunteers shall not be held responsible for any losses or injuries incurred or suffered by any athlete, official or other person in conjunction with the organization or staging of the event. All participants are urged not to be negligent in safeguarding their personal belongings at all times. The aforementioned parties will take no responsibility for missing belongings. Accident Protocol:

In the case of accidents on courses during the event, medical personnel from the Organizing Committee and Ski Patrol personnel will be responsible for any medical decision or evacuation to the local hospital in Trail, BC.
