

ORGANIZING CENTER:

The Organizing Center is located in the Olympic Parc – La Chaudanne - 73550 Méribel. See the location on the map :





ACCOMMODATION:

Teams will be lodged in hotel with half board, from **Sunday night December 12th to Thursday morning December 16th, 2010** (4 nights at the FIS rate, 45 CHF) or to Friday morning December 17th if we use the reserve day. Lunch will be organized by the organizing committee in the finish area (Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday) at the rate of 15 CHF per person. If you don't want it, thank you to tell us before, if not this will be invoiced.

Each coach has to pay his team accommodation expenses directly to the organizing committee the day of his arrival (Sunday 12th). No reservation and no payment will be accepted from the racers.

These conditions will be applied to the members registered on the entry form, which has to be returned to the Organizing Committee <u>before Saturday November 20th 2010</u>. Each team will be held responsible for any damage incurred during their stay.
