The Organizing Committee is pleased to invite all ski cross nations to attend the FIS Freestyle Ski World Cup Ski Cross Grasgehren in Obermaiselstein/Allgäu, as part of the 2010-2011 FIS Freestyle Ski World Cup Tour.

The Organizing Committee will host the event in accordance with the International Ski Competition Rules (I.C.R.) of the FIS. All National Associations affiliated with FIS are invited to compete.

## Rules

1. The Organizing Committee is organizing a FIS Freestyle Ski World Cup Ski Cross competition.
2. The dates for this competition have been published in the International Calendar of the FIS ([www.fis-ski.com/uk/disciplines/freestyle](http://www.fis-ski.com/uk/disciplines/freestyle)).
3. The competition will be held under FIS rules and regulations for freestyle skiing.
4. The competition is comprised of one (1) Ski Cross event in Obermaiselstein/Allgäu for both ladies and men.
5. The competition will follow an official program that will be available to all participants.
6. The organizing committee, subject to the approval of the FIS before the start of the competition and subject to the approval of the jury at the time of the competition, reserve the right to change the schedule of the events from those published in the program, if necessary.

## **Entries and important forms**

## **Deadline for entries**

December 30th, 2010

The team coach must give the final entry of the competitors with their names to the competition secretary no later than January 21th 2011.

## **Registration**

Team registration will take place at the Race Offices in Obermaiselstein (Haus des Gastes). See detailed schedule attached for opening hours. All fees and deposits must be paid upon registration.

## **Accommodation**

Accommodation for athletes and officials is provided at several hotels and guesthouses in the region. Accommodation assignment will be confirmed upon arrival at the Race office. First all teams have to register at the Race Office before heading to the assigned hotel/ guesthouse. According to the FIS Rules on accommodation and half board, each participant will pay CHF 45.00/day/person. Accommodation at the FIS rate will be provided only for the period of January 26 -30, 2011 (max. 4 nights). Each team will be held responsible for any damage incurred during your stay. Extras like phone, laundry, minibar, pay-tv, etc. must be paid by the teams or athletes directly in the hotel/guesthouse.

Please note: Not all accommodations are equipped with waxing facilities. Therefore a central possibility for waxing will be provided in Obermaiselstein.

## **Transportation**

Teams are responsible for their own transportation.

## **Bibs**

All competitors must wear bibs during all official training, competitions and award ceremonies. Missing bibs will be charged to the National Ski Associations.

## **Medical and doping**

Anti-doping control may be conducted for each gender.

## **Liability**

All athletes, officials and other members of their National Ski Association who attend and participate in the event shall do so at their own risk. The Organizing Committee, the resort corporations, FIS, DSV, sponsors and suppliers, their agents, employees and volunteers shall not be held responsible for any losses or injuries incurred or suffered by any athlete, official or other person in conjunction with the organization or staging of the event. All participants are urged not to be negligent in safeguarding their personal belongings at all times. The aforementioned parties will take no responsibility for missing belongings.

## **Accident insurance**

Every competitor must have his/her own medical insurance. The Organizing Committee, Sponsors, Suppliers, the corporations, FIS and DSV decline any responsibility for accidents, damaged equipment and second and third party claims during the event.

## **Accident protocol**

In the case of accidents on courses during the event, medical personnel from the Organizing Committee and Ski Patrol personnel will be responsible for any medical decision or evacuation to the local hospital in cooperation with the National Associations medical personnel identified on the entry form.

## **Free Training possibilities**

There will be offered free training possibilities for the Teams on Thursday, 27th of January from 08:30 - 16:00 a Giant Slalom Course at the Alpine Training Center in Hindelang/Oberjoch as well as a Skitest Area at the Grasgehren Ski Resort.

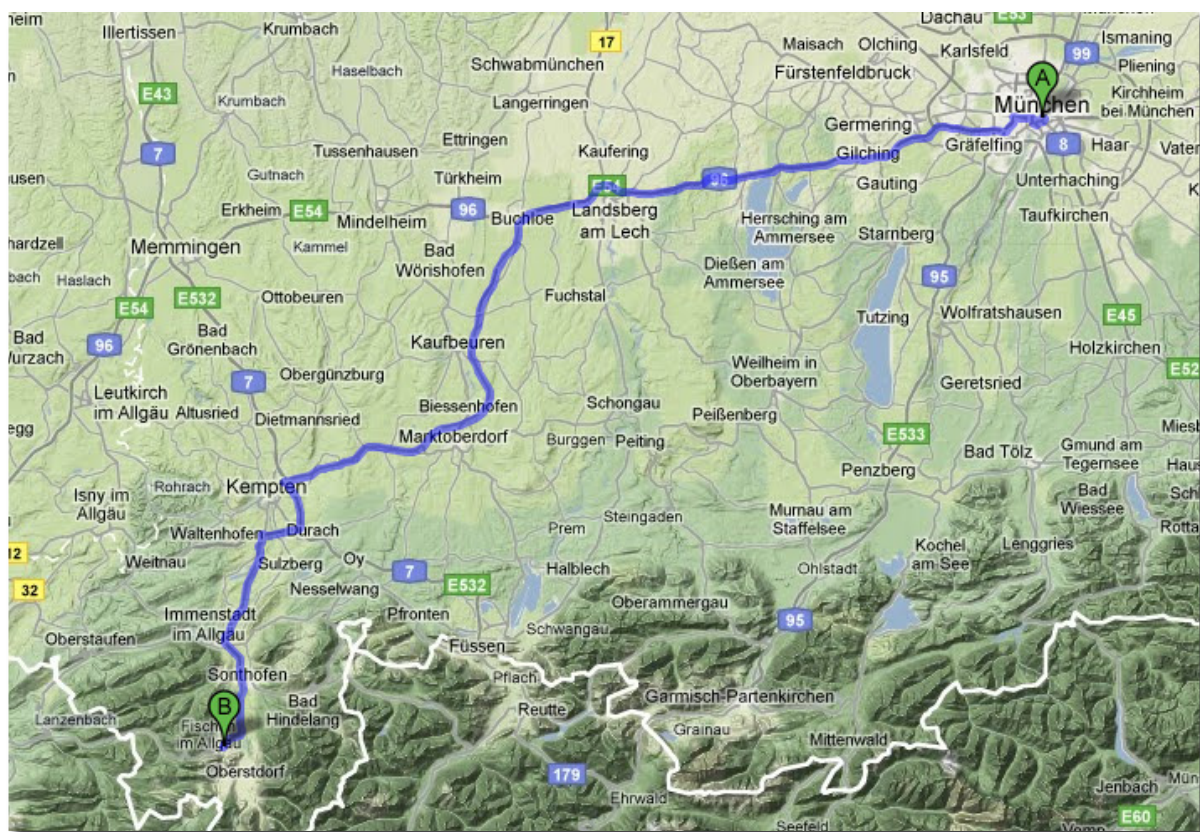

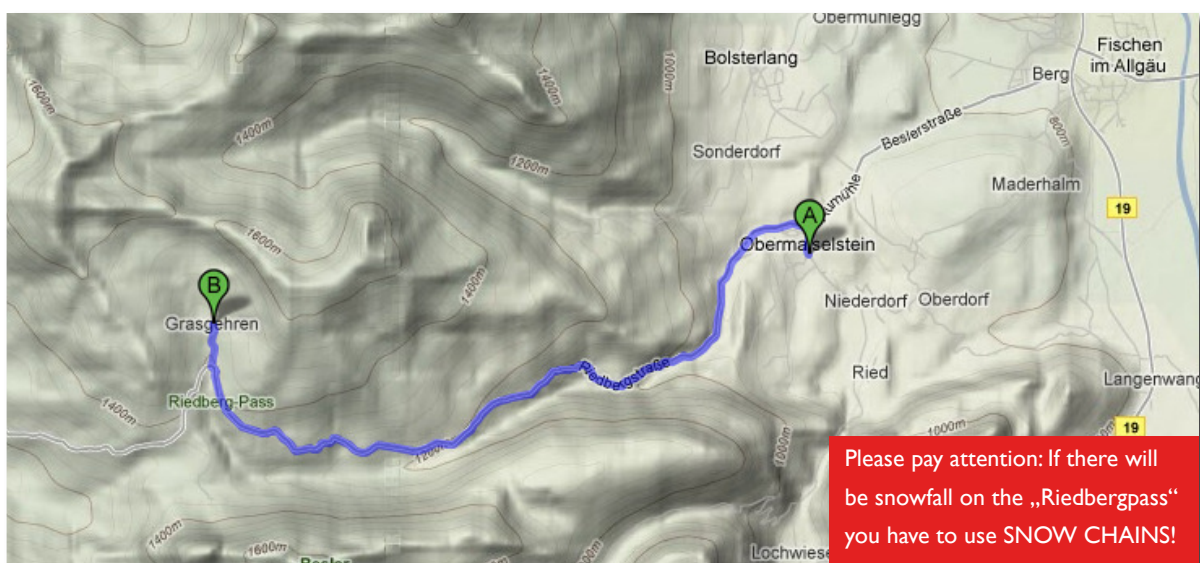
