Lift Tickets:

Park City Mountain Resort offers reduced ticket prices to athletes.

- Athletes must purchase tickets from the resort ticket booth
- Athletes must show/wear bib in addition to be on the official entry list when purchasing tickets
- MC/Visa accepted for lift ticket purchase
- Ticket office opens daily at 7:30 a.m.
- Ticket price \$38.00 (USD)

Complimentary lift tickets for coaching staff, judges and officials are available at the competition office upon check in.

Basic Event Program:

Mogul Skiers will compete in two NorAm events on the Sampson ski run located in the Jupiter Bowl area off of the Pioneer Lift. Spectators and media must have a lift pass to access the competition venue. All awards ceremonies will be directly following the events and located in the Sampson Finish Area.

Travel and Transportation:

Park City Mountain Resort is located in Park City, Utah, just 30 minutes from Salt Lake City, Utah and 45 Minutes from the Salt Lake International Airport.

Team Captains Meeting:

All coaches must attend the 1st Team Captains meeting on Monday, February 7th, final location for Team Captains and Draw is to be determined. Please confirm meeting time with Chief of Competition or Race Secretary.

Statement of Medical Plan:

Copies of the Event Medical Plan are available at the Park City Mountain Resort Race Office upon request.

<u>Bibs:</u>

Athletes not returning their bibs at the end of their final competition run will be charged \$50.00 USD and the bib will be considered lost or stolen as of February 11th, 2011.

Statement of Liability:

All athletes, officials and other members of their National Association who attend and participate in the event shall do so at their own risk. Apex Freestyle Club (organizing committee), Apex Mountain Resort, the Canadian Freestyle Ski Association, sponsors and suppliers, their agents, employees and volunteers shall not be held responsible for any losses or injuries incurred or suffered by any athlete, official or other person in conjunction with the organization or staging of the event. All participants are urged not to be negligent in safeguarding their personal belongings at all times. The aforementioned parties will take no responsibility for missing belongings.







Accident Insurance:

Every competitor must have his/her own medical insurance in accordance with FIS ICR Rule 204.2. The Organizing Committee, Sponsors, Suppliers, Apex Mountain Resort, the Canadian Freestyle Ski Association and the FIS decline any responsibility for accidents, damaged equipment and second and third party claims during the event.

Accident Protocol:

In the case of accidents on courses during the event, medical personnel from the Organizing Committee and Ski Patrol personnel will be responsible for any medical decision or evacuation to the local hospital in co-operation with the National Associations' medical personnel identified on the entry form.

REFUND POLICY (per FIS rules 2010/2011):

If a competition is cancelled, \$45.00 CAN shall be refunded to each athlete registered for that event. An athlete shall receive a maximum refund of \$45.00 CAN per competition, even if she or he is registered in more than one event that is cancelled. If an event is rescheduled at another venue a \$45.00 CAN event entry fee will be charged to the participating athletes.

Athlete Injury Refund Policy: A registered athlete who withdraws from an event, before the generation of the official start list, will receive a refund of 50% of their entry fee. Athletes that appear on the official start list for an event will not be given a refund. No refunds will be given without a written request. All refund requests should be submitted in writing to the organizing committee no later than 7 days after the completion of the last event day.
