RULES

- 1 The Freestyle Federation of Russia and Salma ski resort are organizing European Cup Freestyle competitions for the FIS 2011 freestyle circuit.
- 2 The dates of the competitions are published in the International Calendar of FIS.
- 3 The Competitions are held according to the FIS rules and regulations for freestyle skiing competitions.
- 4 The program of the Competitions comprises two events for both ladies and men: Aerials (2), Moguls, and Dual Moguls.
- The Organizing Committee reserves the right to change the schedule or the place of the events from those stated in the program, according to the snow conditions or the decision of the Competition Jury.

ENTRIES

Entries are accepted from National Ski Associations in accordance with the FIS quotas and must be submitted to the Organizing Committee by mail, fax or E-mail no later than Tuesday, February 1st, 2011. SFR 42 - per competitor and event, i.e. 27 EUR

SFR 62 - per competitor and 2 events. 40 EUR

Entry fees are payable to the Organizing Committee upon registration.

Currency exchange kiosk will be set up on-site. Alternatively currency exchange services are also available in Polyarnye Zori.

VISAS

Most foreign citizens require a valid visa in order to enter Russia.

Please check with your local Russian Embassy or Consulate to determine if you need a visa to travel to Russia and what regulations apply in your case. Contacts of Russian consulates can be found via the Russian Ministry of Foreign Affairs website www.mid.ru (direct link to the MFA website)

To assist you with getting a visa the Organizing Committee should be informed about the form of the documents necessary to obtain a visa and provided a fax number, regular mail address, e-mail or express-mail address as well as the personal details for every participant.

ACCOMMODATION AND RESERVATION

Accommodation for athletes and officials is provided at Salma ski resort. All teams must first register at the Race Office and get an accommodation voucher for a cottage at Salma ski resort or a hotel in Polyarnye Zori.

The Organizing Committee offers the following accommodation options for competition participants:

Cottages 10+1persons:

1st floor:1double sofa, WC, shower, 3 beds, mini-kitchen

2nd floor: 4 bedroom, WC, shower

Hotel in the city 10 km far from SALMA ski resort:

Standard DBL: 1 double bed, shower cabin + WC

Standard TW: 2 beds, shower cabin + WC

MEALS

FB (3 meals a day: breakfast, lunch, dinner)

19 EUR – per person/day

HB (2 meals a day: lunch, dinner)

12 EUR – per person/day

HB (2 meals a day: breakfast, lunch)

10 EUR – per person/day

Please, pay attention to **check out date and time**, when you are to leave the cottages!

METHODS OF PAYMENT

Accommodation as well as entry fees are to be paid to the Organizing Committee in cash at the Race Office during the registration.

RACE OFFICE AND REGISTRATION

During the Competitions the Race Office will be located at Salma ski resort. Team registration procedure for the European Cup competitions will take place daily, starting from Wednesday, 9th of March from 18:00 pm at the Race Office.

TEAM LEADERS MEETING

The first Team Leaders Meeting will be held on Wednesday, 9th of March at 19:00 at the Race Office.







BIBS

All competitors must wear their bibs during all official trainings, competitions and award ceremonies. Each team leader will be asked for a deposit of €20 per bib upon registration.

SKI PASSES

Ski lift tickets for competitors and coaches will be provided on the days of competitions and official trainings free of charge. Other days – 8 EUR per day. Each team leader will be asked for a deposit of 5 EUR per ski lift card upon registration.

AWARD CEREMONY

Award ceremonies will be held right after each event at the special award area.

INSURANCE/LIABILITY

All athletes, officials and other members of the National Associations, who attend and participate in the competitions, shall do so at their own risk. The Organizing Committee, the Russian Freestyle Ski Federation and Salma Ski Resort shall not be responsible for any losses or injuries occurred or suffered by any athlete, official or other person, in accordance with the organization or standing of the event.

Every competitor must have his/her own medical insurance. The Organizing Committee, the Russian Freestyle Ski Federation and Salma Ski Resort decline any responsibility for accidents, damaged equipment and second and third party claims during the competitions. All athletes must have previously signed "FIS Athletes Declaration" form, in order to be registered.

TRANSPORTATION

Teams are responsible for their own transportation from the airport of Murmansk to Salma ski resort and back. Please, note that we have finalized special arrangements with a transport company (see details below). We would advise you to consider their services rather than using public transportation system being relatively expensive and uncomfortable.

Please, provide us with your flight arrival and departure information as soon as possible.

Salma Ski Resort is located about 350 km south of Murmansk airport. It is possible to reach this area by car or coach. We can organize coaches, transporter or passenger car transportation if required

Airport transfer cost:

* Minibus 3-11 seats: 200 EUR (return), 120 EUR (one way)

* Bus 12-50 seats: 300 EUR (return), 180 EUR (one way)







Transportation costs for the teams coming from/via Finland (Kuusamo or Rovaniemi):

* Minibus 3-11 seats 550 EUR (return), 350 EUR (one way)

* Bus 12-50 seats 900 EUR (return), 500 EUR (one way)

The transfer fee should be paid directly to the driver.

Itinerary:

From Murmansk: (Мурманск) to Polyarnie Zori (Полярные Зори) 270km about, Road №M18, down to the St. Petersburg direction Salma Ski Resort respectively. We hope to set some extra road-signs showing the direction for the competition time.

From the boarder SALLA: (operation hours: from 7.00 to 19.00) Kandalaksha (Кандалакша) about 150km, next left turn to the road №М18 direction Murmansk, follow signs Мурманск about 40km, pass the right turn to Polyarnye Zori then after 8km take the left turn to Salma Ski Resort, main crossroad (T-shape). We hope to set some extra road-signs showing the direction for the competition time.
