2. Competition Rules

FIS rules will be applied to this competition

2. Location of the Course

Skiarea: Faloria - Slope: Tondi, beside the ski lift Faloria-Tondi.

Altitude start: 2300 mt. - Altitude finish: 2155 mt. - Vertical Drop: 145 mt.

3. Entries - Event fee

Entries will only be accepted from Nation Ski & Snowboard Associations in accordance with the FIS quotas and rules for the European Cup and must be submitted to the Organizing Committee on official FIS Entry Form (ICR art.215 - see below) by fax or mail, within the mentioned deadline: **2**nd **December, 2010**

Entry fee for each competitor for each day of training or race: € 20,00/day.

Deposit per Team: € 100,00

4. Registration

Team registration will take place at the Race Office, which is located at the "Alexander Hall", Via Marangoi n.1 - Cortina d'Ampezzo: on Thursday 16th December, 17.30 to 18.00 on Friday 17th December, 17.30 to 18.00 on Saturday 18th December, 17.30 to 18.00





5. Accommodation

Accommodation at the special rate 41 € / night / person HB in double and triple room, will be provided in the Concordia Park Hotel, in the centre of Cortina d'Ampezzo, less than 500mt far from the Cable Car to the Skiarea of race, for the official arrival day Thursday December 16th through Sunday December 19th, 2010. Every team has to pay for the accommodation and the personal expenses directly to the hotel cash (EURO-only) or by credit card. Each team will be held responsible for any damage incurred during the stay.

6. Team Captains Meetings

The Team Captains Meetings will be held in the "Alexander Hall", Via Marangoi n.1 – 32043 Cortina d'Ampezzo (same place as the Race Office). Please see schedule for meeting times.

7. Transportation

Teams are responsible for their own transportation.

Every competitor, coach and serviceman has to carry a skiing pass with himself. The skiing pass is available for the event-days at the race office.

8. Bibs

All competitors must wear bibs during the competitions (inspection, official training, qualification and race) and, if requested by the organization, also during the award ceremonies. All bibs have to be returned to the organizers !!!





9. Accident insurance

Each competitor must have his/her own medical insurance and valid medical certificate. The Organizing Committee, the Ski Area, sponsors, suppliers and their agents, the FIS, Italian Ski Federation - FISI and the Snowboard Club Cortina decline any responsibility for accidents, damaged or lost equipment and second and third party claims during the event.

10. Liability

All athletes, officials and members of the National Association who attend and participate in the event shall do it at their own risk. The Organizing Committee, suppliers, their agents, Snowboard Club Cortina, shall not be responsible for any losses or injuries incurred or suffered by any athlete, official or other person in conjunction with the organising or staging of the event.

11. Official Notice Board

The official Notice Board will be located at the race office "Alexander Hall" in Cortina d'Ampezzo and in the finish area of the race.

12. Press and Media

The Press Center will be located at the race office "Alexander Hall" in Cortina d'Ampezzo. All representatives of the press and the media (TV, radio and internet) are requested for accreditation at the event directly to the organization.


