RULES: Rules for the Alpine FIS Continental Cup 2010/2011 apply.

ELIGIBILITY: Refer to Continental Cup Rules 2010/11 Section B Rule ANC 2.3.

Higher Quotas for ANC Nations: Australia may enter up to 30 competitors (30 men and ladies). New Zealand as the organising nation may enter 50 competitors; in addition they are entitled to any of the 30 places Australia does not fill. Competitors from Australia, New Zealand and the African Continent can compete even if they do not have FIS points but they must have a FIS code. See rules ANC.2.3.1 and 2.3.4

FIS Quotas for Visiting Nations: New Zealand has the right to allow a nation from other regions up to double their normal FIS quota provided that all competitors appear on the valid FIS list and have a maximum of 140 FIS points in SL and GS and 160 FIS points in SG qualifying through DH, SG or GS. See rule ANC 2.3.3.

National Federations applying for quota requests must apply in writing, accompanying the official entry form at least ten days prior to the competition. The Organising Committee will make a decision regarding quotas five days prior to the competition.



ENTRY: Entries will be accepted in accordance with the FIS quotas and rules. Entry ***must go through Winter Games NZ online registration system.***

The main purpose of the online system is to replace the manual process of submitting paper-based entry forms by fax or email. The information required to enter is the same as on the FIS forms you would usually submit. You can print a copy for your own records. The link below is only accessible to the National Sport Associations for submitting team entries.

The Registration process works as follows:

1. Click on the link provided to National Sports Associations via email. If your National Association hasn't received it please contact Wayne@wintergamesnz.com.
2. Create a user account for the online system.
3. Once activated you can create teams and add athletes and officials. After you submit a team, you can log back in and edit your team. You can add or remove athletes, edit athletes and officials at any time until registration closes. It will automatically update on our system.
4. To get confirmation of your entry sent to your email, click the button "Send Team list as PDF".
5. Encourage your team athletes to submit their athlete biographies at www.wintergamesnz.com/accounts/register/

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ENTRY DEADLINE: Entries close at 15.00 on Monday 15 August 2011. Entries with quota requests must be made by at least 15.00 on Friday 12 August 2011.

ENTRY FEES: There are no entry fees.

LIFT TICKETS: Lift tickets will be free for competitors on the days they are racing and for coaches of competitors with 1 ticket per 8 same team athletes or part thereof and 50% charge of a day pass for remaining coaches. These complimentary lift tickets will be issued at the beginning of the Team Captain's Meeting for each race. The 50% Day Pass for remaining coaches can be purchased on the night at the Team Captains Meeting for the next days racing.

OPENING CEREMONY: 100% Pure Winter Games NZ Opening party in conjunction with NZSki Rail Jam will be on Friday August 12th 2011 at Queenstown Memorial Park.



CLOSING CEREMONY: Final Awards Ceremony will be held in conjunction with the Methven Big Air in Methven on Saturday August 27th

FIRST TEAM MEETING: Sunday 21 August 2011 at 16.00 Queenstown Memorial Hall.

BIB DEPOSITS: NZ\$100 per team to be paid at the 1st Team Captains Meeting, cash only.

PUBLIC BIB DRAW: Public bib draws will be held to profile the sport at the awards stage at the Queenstown Village Green in Queenstown. The first public Bib draw will be held at 5pm Sunday 21st August.

PRIZE GIVING: All prizegivings will take place daily at the Queenstown Village Green in Queenstown and in front of the Methven Big Air in Methven with entertainment pre and post award ceremonies.
