Entry and Information

Indication of Athletes and Teams

until Friday, November 4th, 2011

Starting permission is only given to athletes starting for their National Ski Association according to the regulations valid for the FIS Cross country World cup season 2011/2012.

IMPORTANT: For the Cross country World Cup events, all teams must make their **hotel bookings and the final team entry online**. You must enter the system on the FIS Website www.fis-ski.com at the member section by using your login to the **FOU system** (same as you need for updating your competitors).

Accommodation

until Friday, November 4th, 2011

The prices indicated are per person and night in double rooms including full board.

3* or 4* Hotel

=> CHF 125.-

For the women's and men's **seeded group** the accommodation cost will be paid by the OC for a max. of 4 nights, starting from Thursday, 8th till Monday, December 12, 2011 for a double room including full board. The OC will inform the hotels about seeded group cost and the delegation bill will be reduced accordingly. All further accommodation cost (such as telephone calls, drinks, garage, etc.) must be paid by the participants themselves directly at the hotel.

The NSA's are obliged to provide to the OC the final size of the team 10 days before the World Cup competition = **Wednesday, November 30, 2011** (size tolerance +/- 10 %). If the NSA changes this figures by more than 10 %, the NSA's are obliged to pay the difference between the effective and announced persons. In any case, if the team size will be bigger than previously announced the effective cost must be paid.

No-show bookings will be charged fully to the National Ski Associations!

Transport services

until Friday, November 4th, 2011

The official World Cup Airport for Davos Nordic is **Zurich International Airport**. Per team, one return transfer from and to the Airport Zurich to Davos is covered by the OC.

Further, unofficial transports will be organised by the OC on request and have to be paid directly on-site or directly to the transport company.

Prices: Airport Zurich – Davos / Davos – Zurich Airport

Reimbursement of travel and accommodation cost – ‚Red Group‘

According to the FIS rules, travel cost for the seeded athletes are paid directly on-site in Davos - after the Team-Captain's Meetings.

The OC will send faxes to the Hotels to inform them about which athletes/coaches will be paid for by the organizer. These costs are then deducted directly from the Nation's hotel bill.

Public Bib-Handover

On Friday, December 9th at 18:30 – 19:00 h a public Bib-Handover to all Swiss-Ski athletes of the international group as well as to the top-10 athletes of the FIS World cup Distance rankings will take place. Each athlete has to attend this ceremony in person. Meeting point: 18:15 h Race office (Nordic Lounge).

Official Award Ceremonies / Prize money

The official Award ceremonies will take place right after the races in the stadium of Davos Nordic. The Prize Giving will include the best six men and best six ladies on each competition. Each athlete has to attend this ceremony in person.

The prize money will be paid to the prize winner's personal bank account. To ensure this transfer, bank account-and personal details for each athlete including a copy of the athlete's passport, must be submitted to the organizer.

Waxing facilities

Wax cabins for the teams will be ready at 'Stilli '(Flüelastrasse) in the official waxing tent by Monday, December 6th. The cabin size accords to the FIS rules. The handover of the cabin keys will take place directly in the waxing tent requiring a deposit of CHF 20.-/EUR 20th -.

At the same time, teams get parking cards - please pay attention to the parking rules and regulations!

Race office / Accreditation

The accreditation of the teams will be handed out to the Team Captains at the Race Office. The Race Office is situated in the 'Nordic Lounge' tent in the starting-/finishing area (stadium) on Bünda.

For all coaches, service people, the FIS season accreditation apply. **Don't forget to bring the FIS Season Accreditations!**


