ENTRIES

FIS has established nation Quotas for World Cup. National Ski Teams can only enter World Cup Ski Competitors according to the Quota limitations. The Quotas can be downloaded http://www.fis-ski.com/data/document/basic-and-additional-quotas-11121.pdf

Competitors entered into FIS Freestyle Ski World Cups must have the minimum required FIS Freestyle Ski points in the respective valid FIS points list.

The minimum FIS point requirements for FIS Freestyle Dual Mogul World Cup events are 50 Mogul FIS points.

The Organizer needs to check on this as soon as they receive the entries.

In addition to complying with the rules for Entries (ICR 215), each entry shall include the following biographical information for the competitor: place of residence, digital image, place of birth, age they started skiing and competition, languages, hobbies, personal competition equipment details and, where available, web and/or social networking site URLs.







RULES

Méribel is organizing an international competition, the 2011 FIS Freestyle Dual Moguls World Cup.

This competition, for both men and women, will be held under the FIS Freestyle Skiing World Cup rules. All national Associations affiliated to the FIS are invited to compete.

According to the FIS international calendar, the competition will take place on December 20th 2011 following the official program.

The Organizing Committee reserves the right to modify the schedule and the place of the event stated in the program, depending on the snow conditions or the decision of the competition jury.



ACCOMMODATION:

Teams will be lodged in hotel with half board, from **Saturday night December 17th to Wednesday morning December 21th, 2011** or to Thursday morning December 22th if we use the reserve day.
