## **Rules**

### **ARTICLE 1**

Oberndorf / St. Johann in Tirol is organizing an international competition, Audi FIS Ski Cross World Cup.

### **ARTICLE 2**

This competition, for both women and men, will be held under FIS rules. At the Audi FIS Ski Cross World Cup all national FIS – affiliated associations are invited to compete.

### **ARTICLE 3**

According to the international calendar of the FIS, the competition will take place from January 6<sup>th</sup> - 7<sup>th</sup>, 2012 and will follow the official programme.

### **ARTICLE 4**

The Organizing Committee reserves the right to modify the timetable and the arranged place of the event depending on the snow conditions, on the decision of the jury or on other aggravating circumstances.

## General Information Registration

### 1. Entries and important forms

Entries will be accepted from National Ski Associations and Company Teams in accordance with the FIS rules for the FIS Freestyle Ski World Cup.

FIS has established nation Quotas for World Cup competitions. National Ski Teams can only enter World Cup Ski competitors according to the Quota limitations. The Quotas can be downloaded:

Competitors entered into FIS Freestyle Ski World Cups must have the minimum required FIS Freestyle Ski points in the respective valid FIS points list or an Alpine equivalent for SX only.

The minimum FIS point requirements per FIS Freestyle Ski Cross World Cup event are:

FIS Points lists	Ski Cross
Freestyle	100
Alpine	50

### 1. Accommodation

As per the FIS Rule on accommodation and half board, each participant will pay SFR 45.— /day/person. Accommodation at the FIS rate will be provided only for the period of January, 5<sup>th</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup>, 2011. Additional overnight stays have to be paid separately by the team or athlete. Payment **at the Check-In** (in Cash or by Credit Card) in the Race Office.

The exchange rate will be according to the policy of the FIS Freestyle Skiing Committee.

Each team will be held responsible for any damage incurred during your stay. Any kind of extras like phone, laundry, minibar, pay-tv, etc. must be paid by the teams or athletes.

### 2. Transportation

Teams are responsible for their own transportation.

Please feel free to contact us for airport transfers, rental car service or any other form of transportation. To help us better prepare for your visit, please provide us with your (flight) arrival and departure information as soon as possible.

## **Competition**

### **1. BIBS**

All competitors must wear bibs during all official training, competition and award ceremonies.

### **2. Accident Insurance**

Each competitor must have his/her own medical insurance. The Organizing Committee, sponsors, suppliers, their agents, the FIS and the Austrian Ski association decline any responsibility for accidents, damaged or lost equipment and second and third party claims during the event.

### **3. Liability**

All athletes, officials and members of the National Associations who attend and participate in the event shall do so at their own risk. The Organizing Committee, the Austrian Ski Association, sponsors and suppliers, their agents, employees and volunteers shall not be responsible for any losses or injuries incurred or suffered by any athlete, official or other person in conjunction with the organizing or staging of the event.
