# Rules

## **ARTICLE 1**

Kreischberg/Murau is organizing an international competition, FIS Freestyle World Cup - Aerials

## **ARTICLE 2**

This competition, for both women and men, will be held under FIS rules. At the Freestyle World Cup all national FIS – affiliated associations are invited to compete.

## **ARTICLE 3**

According to the international calendar of the FIS, the competition will take place at February, 17<sup>th</sup>, 2012 and will follow the official programme.

## **ARTICLE 4**

The Organizing Committee reserves the right to modify the timetable and the place of the event depending on the snow conditions, on the decision of the jury or on other aggravating circumstances.

## **General Information & Registration**

### **1. Entries and important forms**

FIS has established nation Quotas for World Cup. National Ski Teams can only enter World Cup Ski Competitors according to the Quota limitations. The Quotas can be downloaded <http://www.fis-ski.com/data/document/basic-and-additional-quotas-11121.pdf>

Competitors entered into FIS Freestyle Ski World Cups must have the minimum required FIS Freestyle Ski points in the respective valid FIS points list. One athlete per nation per gender can be entered that have between 50-100 FIS Freestyle Aerials FIS points. All other athletes need to have the minimum FIS points for FIS Freestyle Aerial World Cup events which are 100 FIS points. The Organizer needs to check on this as soon as they receive the entries.

### **Deadlines for entries:**

**January, 18<sup>th</sup>, 2012 Announcement of Team size**

**February, 9<sup>th</sup>, 2012 Definitive registration**

The final entry of the competitors with their names must be given by the team coach to the competition secretary no later than two hours before the draw of the competition.

## 2. Registration

Team registration will take place starting at February, 14<sup>th</sup> 2012 in the **Race Office:** Kreischberg Halle, next to Kreischberg lift station/event area

## 3. Accommodation

As per the FIS Rule on accommodation and half board, each participant will pay CHF 45.- (EUR 36,30) /day/person for the period of February, 14<sup>th</sup> to 18<sup>th</sup>, 2012.

Additional overnight stays have to be paid separately by the team or athlete.

Payment in full (100%) **upon registration** (Cash or Credit Card – MasterCard/Visa) in the Tourist Office.

Each team will be held responsible for any damage incurred during your stay.

Any kind of extras like phone, laundry, minibar, pay-tv, etc. must be paid by teams or athletes.

## 4. Transportation

Teams are responsible for their own transportation.

Next airports: Graz 150 km, Salzburg 160 km, Vienna 250 km, Munich 320 km



# Competition

## 1. BIBS

All competitors must wear bibs during all official training, competition and prize-giving ceremonies.

## 2. Accident Insurance

Each competitor must have his/her own medical insurance. The Organizing Committee, sponsors, suppliers, their agents, the FIS and the Austrian Ski association decline any responsibility for accidents, damaged or lost equipment and second and third party claims during the event.

## 3. Liability

All athletes, officials and members of the National Associations who attend and participate in the event shall do so at their own risk. The Organizing Committee, the Austrian Ski Association, sponsors and suppliers, their agents, employees and volunteers shall not be responsible for any losses or injuries incurred or suffered by any athlete, official or other person in conjunction with the organizing or staging of the event.
