





General Registration Information

1. ENTRIES

Entries will be accepted in accordance with the FIS rules. National Ski Teams can only enter World Cup Aerial competitors according to the Quota limitations.

The 2011/2012 FIS Freestyle Skiing World Cup Quota Calculations – Basic and Additional Spots can be downloaded here:

Competitors entered into FIS Freestyle Ski World Cups must have the minimum required FIS Freestyle Ski points in the respective valid FIS points list. One athlete per nation per gender can be entered that have between 50-100 FIS Freestyle Aerials FIS points. All other athletes need to have the minimum FIS points for FIS Freestyle Aerial World Cup events which are 100 FIS points.

Entries will be accepted from National Ski Associations within the FIS quotas and World Cup rules and must be submitted to the Organizing Committee. Please complete the enclosed Preliminary Entry (Form 2), accommodation application (Form 3) and transportation request (Form 4) by January 26, 2012.

The **FINAL** (Form 1.) definitive registration (by name, confirmation of team size, arrival and departure dates) must be confirmed to the Organizing Committee **by February 17**, **2012.**









VISA

To travel to Belarus, you are required to have a **Visa**. Once we have your team entries, we will send a letter of invitation **by name**. This invitation by name is the requirement when you make an application for a visa. See visa application form attached.

2. REGISTRATION

The registration will take place at the official hotel in Raubichi **Tuesday, February 21st**, from 12:00-21:00

To be eligible for participation in the 2011/2012 FIS Freestyle Ski World Cup, each competitor must be a citizen of the country from the National Ski Association. He or she must have a FIS Code and prove it with a valid passport. All fees and deposits must be paid **in cash** upon registration.

3. ACCOMMODATION

As per the FIS Rule for accommodation and half board, each participant will pay the Organizing Committee the **American Dollar** or **Euro** equivalent of 45 Swiss francs per night (according to the FIS Rate as set in the World Cup Rules) **in cash**.

Please, note the check-in hour is 12 a.m., checkout hour is 10 a.m.

The accommodation will be provided from the dinner of 21^{st} to the breakfast of 26^{th} February (5 nights).

Early arrivals and late departures are subject to availability and are not available at the FIS Rate. The hotel rates for early arrival and late departure are available upon request.

Each team will be responsible for any damage incurred during their stay.

4. TRANSPORTATION

Please specify Minsk-2 Airport or Minsk Railway station as your point of arrival.

The Organizing Committee will help to arrange the transfer of teams from Minsk-2 Airport and Minsk Railway station and back.

25 USD per person is charged for the service of transportation (Minsk-2 Airport/Minsk Railway station).









5. BIBS

All competitors must wear bibs during all official training, competition and award ceremonies. 20 US dollars deposit per bib will be charged upon registration.

6. LIABILITY

All athletes, officials and other members of the National Associations or Federations who will attend and participate in the competitions shall do so at their own risk of any injuries or losses suffered or incurred during the competitions.

8. ACCIDENT INSURANCE

Anti-doping control may be conducted for each event and gender.
