



## CANADA POST FREESTYLE GRAND PRIX AT CANADA OLYMPIC PARK

**JANUARY, 2012**

*As part of the 2011-2012 FIS Freestyle Ski World Cup*

**January 28-29, 2012**

The Canadian Freestyle Ski Association is pleased to invite all freestyle nations to attend the **FIS Freestyle Ski World Cup** at Canada Olympic Park in Calgary, part of the 2011-2012 FIS Freestyle Ski World Cup. The Organizing Committee will host the event in accordance with the International Ski Competition Rules (I.C.R.) of the FIS. All national associations affiliated with FIS are invited to compete.

### 2. RULES

- 2.1 The Canadian Freestyle Ski Association, WinSport Canada and the Alberta Freestyle Ski Association are organising a Freestyle FIS competition, part of the 2011-2012 FIS Freestyle Ski World Cup.
- 2.2 The dates for this competition have been published in the International Calendar of the FIS. (See [http://www.fis-ski.com/uk/604/1228.html?event\\_id=29757&cal\\_suchsector=FS](http://www.fis-ski.com/uk/604/1228.html?event_id=29757&cal_suchsector=FS))
- 2.3 The competition will be held under FIS rules and regulations for freestyle skiing.
- 2.4 The competition is comprised of one (1) Moguls event and one (1) Aerials for both ladies and men.
- 2.5 The competition will follow an official program that will be available to all participants.
- 2.6 The organizing committee and the Canadian Freestyle Ski Association, subject to the approval of the FIS before the start of the competition and subject to the approval of the jury at the time of the competition, reserve the right to change the schedule of the events from those published in the program, if necessary.



### 3. ENTRIES AND IMPORTANT FORMS

Entries will be accepted from National Ski Associations in accordance with the FIS quotas and rules and must be submitted to the Organizing Committee.

FIS has established nation Quotas for World Cup. National Ski Teams can only enter World Cup Ski Competitors according to the Quota limitations. The Quotas can be downloaded <http://www.fis-ski.com/data/document/basic-and-additional-quotas-11121.pdf>

Competitors entered into FIS Freestyle Ski World Cups must have the minimum required FIS Freestyle Ski points in the respective valid FIS points list.

The minimum FIS point requirements for FIS Freestyle Moguls and Dual Mogul World Cup events are 50 and for Aerials 100 FIS points.

The Organizer needs to check on this as soon as they receive the entries.

**As per FIS WC rule 7.2.1**, the Announcement of team size (competitors, coaches, accompanying persons and service persons) must be provided to the organizing committee no later than **December 28, 2011**, 4 weeks prior to the event.

Teams are to provide a preliminary **rooming list, by Names** by December 28, 2011.

**As per FIS WC rule 7.2.2**, the Definitive registration (by name, confirmation of team size, arrival and departure dates) must be confirmed to the organizing committee by **January 21, 2012, 4 days prior to the arrival.**

The final entries of the competitors with their names must be given by the team coach to the Chief of Competition no later than two (2) hours before the draw of each competition as per FIS Rule No. 217.1.

### 4. EVENT SCHEDULE

### 5. REGISTRATION

Team registration will take place on **Monday, January 23, 2012, starting at 08:00 a.m. and Tuesday, January 24, 2012, starting at 8:00 a.m.**, at the Westin Calgary Hotel at 320 4th Ave. S.W., Calgary, subject to change. Registration will move to the Event Race Office on Wednesday January 25, 2012 located at ATCO Centre, Canada Olympic Park, 88 Canada Olympic

Road SW, Calgary, Alberta. Canada Olympic Park [website](#). View Canada Olympic Park in [Google Maps](#).

All fees and deposits must be paid in full (100%) upon registration. The Organizing Committee will accept CASH, VISA or MasterCard.

**Please note that each individual being accredited must report to the Race Office to obtain a lift pass.**

## **6. ACCOMMODATION**

Accommodation for athletes and officials is provided at Westin Calgary, located in downtown Calgary, 15 minutes from Canada Olympic Park (website: [www.westincalgary.com](http://www.westincalgary.com)). Teams may register at the Westin Calgary upon arrival in Calgary and must get an accommodation voucher before checking in at the hotel's front desk.

As per the FIS Rule on accommodation and half board, each participant will pay the Organizing Committee the Canadian dollar equivalent of **CHF 45.00** per day (\$49.90 CAD per day) based on double occupancy as defined in the FIS Freestyle Ski World Cup Rules – 2011/2012.

### **Accommodation will be provided as follows:**

The Organizing Committee will provide lodging for:

- Mogul Teams - starting from **arrival on Wednesday, January 25, 2012 and departure on Sunday, January 29, 2012.**
- Aerial Teams – starting from **arrival on Thursday, January 26, 2012 and departure on Monday, January 30, 2012.**

The Organizing Committee regrets to advise you that we may not be able to assist with accommodations before or after these dates.

At the time of check-in at the hotel, a fully refundable damage deposit charged to a major credit card will be required (**a credit card is required**). Each National Association (Team) will be held responsible for any damage incurred during its stay.

**IMPORTANT:**

1. Team Captains will pay the FIS Rate for the accommodation and meal program at the Event Office
2. Teams must confirm entries by name and rooming lists for accommodation no later than Saturday, January 21, 2012.
3. Last minute cancellations or changes to the confirmed rooming list will not be tolerated. At registration, Team Captains will be charged in full (100%) for the dates and amount of athletes and officials submitted on the official entry form / team size form as of Saturday January 21, 2012.
4. **FULL PAYMENT** for each team member of 45 CHF (exchange rate \$49.90 CAD) per day (for meal program and accommodation) is required at registration. Exchange rates are established as defined in the 2011-2012 FIS Freestyle Ski World Cup Rules. Any additional officials (defined in World Cup Rule #7.4.2) and service personnel (defined in World Cup Rule #7.4.3) will be charged 70 CHF per day for half board and accommodations.
5. Qualified additional personnel who do not meet the quotas established must be prepared to pay for lodging (if available) and meals prior to receiving credentials.
6. Teams will be responsible for any additional costs incurred by the Organizing Committee as a result of changes made after January 21, 2012. Refunds will not be paid to Teams after January 21, 2012 for rooms released or not occupied by the Teams after January 21, 2012.
7. If teams book rooms outside of the official arrival and departures dates as defined in the invitation, teams will be charged C\$108.00 per room per night + applicable taxes (C\$120.96). Payment in full will be required at registration for additional accommodation charges. Meals will not be provided.
8. All additional charges to the rooms are the responsibility of the Team Captain. **No additional charges will be made to or accepted by the Organising Committee.**

## **7. MEALS**

Two (2) meals per day will be provided, commencing with dinner on Wednesday, January 25, 2012 and concluding with breakfast on Monday, January 30, 2012. Complete information will be provided upon check-in at the Race Office / Accreditation Centre. Meals will be provided at the Westin Calgary hotel. Refunds will not be provided for unused meal tickets.

## **8. GROUND TRANSPORTATION**

Teams are responsible for looking after their own ground transportation to and from the airport to the Westin Calgary hotel and Canada Olympic Park. Suggestions for a rental car company are included in the Team Information Package sent out with the event invitation.

## **9. TEAM LEADERS' MEETING**

The first Team Leader's meeting will be held on **Wednesday, January 25, 2012 at 3:30 p.m (subject to change)** at the Olympic Hall of Fame Room located at Canada Olympic Park.

## **10. BIBS & ACCREDITATION**

All competitors must wear bibs during all official training, competition and award ceremonies. A refundable deposit of \$20 CAD per bib will be charged upon registration.

All competitors, coaches and support staff must wear official event accreditation at all times to access the lifts at Canada Olympic Park.

#### **11. ANTI-DOPING CONTROL**

Anti-Doping Control may take place during the Event in accordance with WADA and FIS guidelines.

#### **12. LIABILITY**

All athletes, officials and other members of their National Association who attend and participate in the event shall do so at their own risk. The Organizing Committee, WinSport Canada, the Canadian Snowsports Association, the Canadian Freestyle Ski Association, sponsors and suppliers, their agents, employees and volunteers shall not be held responsible for any losses or injuries incurred or suffered by any athlete, official or other person in conjunction with the organisation or staging of the event. All participants are urged not to be negligent in safeguarding their personal belongings at all times. The aforementioned parties will take no responsibility for missing belongings.

#### **13. ACCIDENT INSURANCE**

Every competitor must have his/her own medical insurance. The Organizing Committee, Sponsors, Suppliers, WinSport Canada, the FIS, the Canadian Snowsports Association and the Canadian Freestyle Ski Association decline any responsibility for accidents, damaged equipment and second and third party claims during the event.

#### **14. ACCIDENT PROTOCOL**

In the case of accidents on courses during the event, medical personnel from the Organizing Committee and Ski Patrol personnel will be responsible for any medical decision or evacuation to the local hospital in co-operation with the National Associations' medical personnel identified on the entry form.

#### **15. SKI STORAGE**

The competitors, coaches and officials must store their skis and grooming equipment, in their hotel room.

#### **16. WAXING AREA**

The competitors, coaches and ski technicians must wax their skis in the areas provided. Ski waxing will not be allowed in your hotel room or any other area other than the designated waxing areas.
