## General Information Registration

### 1. ENTRIES

Entries will be accepted in accordance with the FIS quotas and rules. FIS has established nation Quotas for World Cup competitions. National Ski Teams can only enter World Cup Ski Competitors according to the Quota limitations. The Quotas can be downloaded

Competitors entered into FIS Freestyle Ski World Cups must have the minimum required FIS Freestyle Ski points in the respective valid FIS points list or an Alpine equivalent for SX only.

The minimum FIS point requirements per FIS Freestyle Ski Cross World Cup event are:

Freestyle	100
Alpine	50

## 2. REGISTRATION

The registration will take place starting on Tuesday, January 31st, from 07:00 - 19:00. Prior to hotel check-in, teams are required to go directly to the Race Office located in the Grand Central Base Lodge ([http://conferences.bluemountain.ca/grand\\_central\\_lodge.htm](http://conferences.bluemountain.ca/grand_central_lodge.htm)). Race Office hours will be from 07:00 to 19:00 from Tuesday, January 31 to Friday, February 3.

All fees must be paid upon registration by a designated team representative.

## 2. ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for participation in the 2012 AUDI FIS Ski Cross World Cup, each competitor must be a citizen of the country from the National Ski Association. He or she must have a valid FIS Code. All fees and deposits must be paid in cash or credit card upon registration.

## 3. ACCOMMODATION

Accommodation and meal services will be at either the Cranberry Resort (<http://www.thecranberryresort.com/>), the Holiday Inn Collingwood ([http://www.collingwood-hotels.com/photos\\_collingwood.html](http://www.collingwood-hotels.com/photos_collingwood.html)), or the Blue Mountain Inn ([http://www.bluemountain.ca/lodging\\_blue\\_inn\\_1.htm](http://www.bluemountain.ca/lodging_blue_inn_1.htm)) from Tuesday night January 31 to Saturday morning February 4th 2012 (4 nights at the FIS rate, 45 CHF). As per the FIS Rule on accommodation and half pension, all competitors and team officials will pay the Organizing Committee the Cdn dollar (in cash or credit card) equivalent of 45 Swiss Francs (\$49.90/Cdn) per day (according to the FIS Rate as set in the World Cup Rules). Each coach has to pay his/her team accommodation expenses on arrival day. No reservation and no payment will be accepted from the competitors. Each team will be responsible for any damage incurred during their stay.

**One single room per country will be provided.** It is the responsibility of the team to determine who receives this room. An odd number resulting in a 2<sup>nd</sup> single room will be charged at the equivalent of 70 Swiss Francs. Any additional single rooms requested will be provided only if available and at market rate.

These conditions will be applied to anyone registered on the entry form, which must be returned to the Organizing Committee before January 4<sup>th</sup>, 2012. All competitors must wear bibs during all official training, competition and award ceremonies.

All athletes, officials and other members of the National Associations or Federations who will attend and participate in the competitions shall do so at their own risk of any injuries or losses suffered or incurred during the competitions.

February 4<sup>th</sup>: Saturday - Departure Day athletes and teams

## 8. ACCIDENT INSURANCE

Every competitor must have his/her own medical insurance. In the case of accidents on courses during competition or training, the medical personnel from the Organizing Committee will be responsible for any medical decision to local hospital in co-operation with the respective team's medical personnel.

## 9. MEDICAL AND DOPING

Anti-doping control may be conducted for each event and gender.
