12th January 2012: Announcement of team size (entry form and travelling form)

3rd February 2012: Definitive registration

VISA

To travel to China, you are required to have a **Visa**. Please fill the form "Information for VISA". Once we have your team entries and visa form, we will send a letter of invitation **by name**. This invitation by name is the requirement when you make an application for a visa.

2. REGISTRATION

The registration for Aerial teams will take place on Monday, February 7th, from 09:00--21:00 at the official hotel in Beida Lake.

The registration for Mogul teams will take place on Wednesday, February 9th, from 09:00--21:00 at the official hotel in Beida Lake.

To be eligible for participation in the 2011/2012 FIS Freestyle Ski World Cup, each competitor must be a citizen of the country from the National Ski Association. He or she must have a FIS Code and the required FIS Points as described below and prove this with a valid passport. All fees and deposits must be paid in cash or credit card upon registration.

FIS has established nation Quotas for World Cup. National Ski Teams can only enter World Cup Ski Competitors according to the Quota limitations. The Quotas can be downloaded <http://www.fis-ski.com/data/document/basic-and-additional-quotas-11121.pdf>

Competitors entered into FIS Freestyle Ski World Cups must have the minimum required FIS Freestyle Ski points in the respective valid FIS points list. One athlete per nation per gender can be entered that have between 50-100 FIS Freestyle Aerials FIS points respectively 25-50 FIS Freestyle Moguls FIS points. All other athletes need to have the minimum FIS points for FIS Freestyle Aerial World Cup events which are 100 FIS points or 50 FIS points for Moguls.

The Organizer needs to check on this as soon as they receive the entries.

3. ACCOMMODATION

As per the FIS Rule on accommodation and half pension, each participant will pay the Organizing Committee the US dollar or Euro in cash or credit card equivalent of 45 Swiss Francs per day (according to the FIS Rate as set in the World Cup Rules). **The accommodation for aerial teams will from the dinner of 7th to the breakfast of 12th, for Mogul teams will from the dinner of 9th to the breakfast of 13th. Early arrivals and late departures are subject to availability and are not available at the FIS Rate. The hotel rates for early arrival and late departure are available upon request.**

Each team will be responsible for any damage incurred during their stay.

4. TRANSPORTATION

Please specify Changchun Airport as your point of arrival. The Organizing Committee will help to arrange the pick-up and drop off at the Changchun Airport. Please fill the travelling form if you need the transportation service.

70 USD per person is charged for the service of transportation.

5. BIBS

All competitors must wear bibs during all official training, competition and award ceremonies. 20 US dollars deposit per bib will be charged upon registration.

6. LIABILITY

All athletes, officials and other members of the National Associations or Federations who will attend and participate in the competitions shall do so at their own risk of any injuries or losses suffered or incurred during the competitions.
